Our goal is always to provide a quality experience for all of our members and their guests.




nformation From the Lake Committee:

Keeping our lake waters clear and preventing bank erosion is always a challenge. Our storm drains all feed into the lakes and the banks sides will collapse if not protected due to the rise and fall of the water levels. There are couple of ways home-owners might want to volunteer some help mitigating these issues.

To minimize silt run-off, consider planting native trees and bushes or other dense vegetation along shorelines, the deeper the better. As an added bonus those plant roots are far longer than grass so they will help bind the banks together. The Lake Committee will provide a list of suitable plants on request. If you desire the list, please contact KPM Management at at 281- 685-3090.

Grass clippings thrown up and into the water are always a problem so please try to communicate this to your yard crew. Perhaps a bigger problem is the over-use of fertilizers, which can cause algae blooms. If you have to use fertilizer, we recommend only low or zero phosphorus products. We recommend no use of fertilizer within 25 feet of the shoreline.

As a reminder, please do not park/store trailers, boats, RVs, tractors, etc. for longer than 10 hours. Parking for longer than that is a deed violation.

Our Rules Chairman, Penelope Murphy, has an official ruling for us. Thank you, Penelope.

Decisions of the Rules of Golf 8-2a/1:

Q: A player places a club on the ground parallel to the line of play to assist him in aligning his feet properly. Is this permissible?

A: Yes, provided the player removes the club before playing his stroke. Otherwise, a breach of Rule 8-2a would occur. Penalty is 2 strokes in Stroke Play. Loss of hole in Match Play.

HOWEVER, Use of Rod During Round for Alignment or as Swing Aid. Decision 14-3/10

Q: During a stipulated round, a player uses a rod to check his alignment or his swing plane.

A: Player is disqualified under Rule 14-3 as the rod is unusual equipment and such case, during the stipulated round is not permitted.

DID YOU KNOW?

With so many new residents and golf members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain our food and beverage service charge policy.

Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait staff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public, the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that particular table as a tip.

However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage.

In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times.

All our servers are paid an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this change in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience.


