

he POA will soon be adopting a new policy regarding the EZ tag access through all of the resident gates. The EZ tag system was set up to ease the congestion at the front gate and to make it easier for residents to enter, by not having to stop at the attendant each time. The EZ Tag system is not a right of ownership, but a benefit to residents. In the near future, residents that have unpaid annual maintenance fees, unpaid gate damage/strike fees, unresolved deed violations, unpaid maintenance fees, and unpaid ACC violation fees will have their EZ tag access suspended until fees are paid or approved payment plans are in order. In 2017 there was a point in which over \$70,000.00 dollars was owed to the POA by residents who did not pay their bills. These funds are vital to the operation of the POA. It is not fair that residents get to use this benefit while not paying their dues like everyone else. There will be a full policy shown at the next POA meeting and at that time many questions can be answered, and details can be provided. If you are one of these residents and would like to avoid interruption to your EZ tag, please contact KPM for payment. We all understand that life can rapidly change directions and that we all can fall on hard times; therefore, this suspension policy will not apply if you have established and are current on your payment plans, or if you have specifically worked out a plan with the POA. We hope to see you at the next POA meeting February 22nd, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

# DID YOU KNOW?



With so many new residents and golf members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain our food and beverage service charge policy.

Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait staff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public, the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that particular table as a tip.

However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage.

In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times.

All our servers are paid an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this charge in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience.



There are a variety of formats planned for the February Tuesday and Thursday plays, so come out and enjoy a fun round of golf with your fellow SMGA members.


#### **Tournament News**
