




Carol Clark won the door prize, a seasonal decoration generously donated by the creative **Cindy Montgomery**.



History of the Randon Bottom Cemetery

After Mexico achieved independence from Spain, Anglo-Americas started moving into Texas from the east. In 1822, a group of Stephen F. Austin's colonists, headed by William Travis, built a fort at the present site of Richmond. The fort was called "Fort Bend," since it was built in the bend of the Brazos River. The fertile and coveted land along the Brazos River was bestowed to the settlers by Stephen F. Austin in his role as a land impresario. As part of the "Old Three Hundred," the Randon family was issued a land parcel which was known as the John Randon League. The Harris Plantation was part of this league and is thought to have contained the whole of what is now Weston Lakes.

The Harris Plantation engaged in extensive rice farming and pecan harvesting. As with other plantations in the south, black slaves lived and worked on the plantation until the end of the Civil War. After that time, many former slaves remained as sharecroppers. The Randon Bottom Cemetery, located within Weston Lakes, is an inactive cemetery that was used from 1908 until 1972 and is the final resting place for the descendants of these sharecropping families. If the cemetery was used prior to 1908, there is no recorded evidence of that. Because the cemetery is located in a ravine area, floods have washed away some of the headstones and markers, over the years making it hard to determine the exact location of all of the graves. The earliest birthdate of record belongs to William Jackson who was born in 1862, and many of the others were born prior to the turn of the nineteenth century. The cemetery also contains the final resting place of three known veterans of the United States Armed Services.
