

The heat is brutal in August. Find the shade and stay hydrated. Have a wet towel available to put around your neck, wear a wide brimmed hat to cover your face and ears, and if possible, have a fan in your cart!

Don't leave your clubs in the trunk during the summer. The heat inside your car trunk can soar very high and cause problems for your equipment. The heat can melt the glue where the shaft and club head meet and loosen the head. If you have seen a club head fly off on the course or range, chances are this was heat related. Your grips may soften and loosen as well while your golf balls could soften and may get out of round. You may keep your car in your garage, but there are plenty of times when you will park in the sun. Always keep the clubs clean, dry and cool so that they last and perform well.

Some of the plant ID apps are general, while others relate specifically to flowers, trees, or shrubs. These apps will also often link to more detailed information such as USDA Hardiness Zones, when and where to plant, soil and fertilization requirements, etc. Once the app is loaded onto your phone, identifying plants is simply a snapshot away! Many of the apps are free, so give one a try the next time you discover a mystery plant and want to learn more about it.



Lateral Water Hazard



Ball played from teeing ground at Point A comes to rest in lateral water hazard at Point B having last crossed the margin of the hazard at Point C. Player's options are as follows:

- play ball as it lies without penalty at Point B, o under penalty of one stroke:
- · play another ball from teeing ground
- drop a ball behind the hazard anywhere on the

broken line from Point D backwards

- · drop a ball in the shaded area at Point C (i.e. within two club-lengths of point C but not nearer the hole than Point C), or
- · drop a ball in the shaded area at Point E (i.e. within two club-lengths of Point E but not nearer to the hole than Point E).

If your ball is in a lateral water hazard (red stakes and/or lines), in addition to the options for a ball in a water hazard (see above), under penalty of one stroke, you may drop within two club-lengths of, and not nearer the hole than the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard.
