



I'd like to go over a few tips for speeding up play on the golf course:

- 1 Play ready golf, where order of play is based on who's ready, not on who's away.
- 2 If you are unsure whether your ball is out of bounds or may be lost, hit a "provisional" ball so that you won't have to return to replay the shot.
- 3 Begin reading the green & lining up putts as soon as you reach the green. Don't wait until it's your turn to putt to start the process of reading the green.
- 4 Mark your score card and put your clubs away after reaching the next tee, not while lingering on or near the just completed green.
- 5 Pay attention to your playing partners' hits. If they lose sight of their ball, you can help direct them to it & avoid excessive search time.
- 6 On play day, limit practice strokes to one or two at the most. If you need more than that, it is for the practice facility.
- 7 1st person to hole their putt should retrieve the flat & be ready to replace it when all players have putted out.
- 8 On cart path only holes, take more than one club with you so you won't have to walk back.

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
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DID YOU KNOW?

Waterside Grill

With so many new residents and golf members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain our food and beverage service charge policy.

Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait staff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public, the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that particular table as a tip.

However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage.

In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times.

All our servers are paid an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this change in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience.


