




#### Red Ball Tournament



Projects in progress:

## **Front Gates Beautification Project;**

At the request of, and in conjunction with, the Weston Lakes POA, Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful has been asked to undertake a project to beautify the front gate entrances at the Weston Lakes and the Waterford main entrances. ## **Executive Director Minute**

We are thankful to live in such a great city with wonderful neighbors. That was never more evident than when we all pulled together to help residents inside and outside our city this past month. I am so grateful for all the support and volunteerism for Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful. As I have said in the past, all of these projects would not be possible without the commitment of our Board of Directors, Committee Chairs, Committee members, and the support of Weston Lakes' residents. Without their dedication and effort the mission of Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful could not be realized.

But I believe we all need each other's support in an "additional" way. Our residents and our supporters are providing thousands of dollars to Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful for these beautification projects. Keeping our city beautiful helps our property values and gives us a sense of pride in our city. But vandalism, primarily by our children and young adults in our city, is becoming a problem. Over the past few months, I and our members have personally witnessed children on golf carts or ATV's tear through the cemetery, damage our parks' grass, paint on our park's fences, and urinating on the cemetery's hedge. Last week, they used a golf cart to tear through the yellow caution tape at Pecan Park only to destroy the newly seeded Bluebonnet and Wildflower project discussed above. When I see this personally, I speak to these kids, and they have always been respectful, but they know that what they are doing is wrong.

Residents are beginning to file Sheriff and Constable Reports, especially after they realize thousands of their donated dollars are being invested into these individual projects only to have them damaged or destroyed. Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful encourages the parents of these children to talk to them and enforce the rules. Help them understand the importance of our city, keeping it beautiful and the financial damage this activity causes. The Sheriff's office has explained that these infractions carry financial fines to the parents, and in the case of the cemetery, a fine and potential time in jail. This is a serious issue for all of us, so we ask your cooperation to eliminate this type of vandalism to our parks and cemetery. We all thank you in advance for your help.
