

CONGRATULATIONS WESTON LAKES!

The Keep Texas Beautiful, Governor's Community Achievement Awards (GCAA) have officially been announced!

For more than thirty years, Keep Texas Beautiful, in partnership with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), has awarded the prestigious Governor's Community Achievement Awards to Texas communities for their outstanding overall efforts to keep their communities beautiful.

This year, Weston Lakes, in only its first year of existence garnered 3rd place overall for all Texas cities with a population of less than 3,000 people, as well as the Award of Excellence for receiving a score of 90 or above. Sara Nichols, Keep Texas Beautiful Program Director, announced it had some truly amazing nominations this year and are proud of what all our communities are doing to Keep Texas Beautiful.

This recognition positions Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful well for the 2018 GCAA and we will continue to strive for 1st place and the \$90,000 award grant that comes with it!



Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful also received "Silver Star" Affiliate 2018 Recognition Standing. Affiliates who have completed their recognition requirements to meet Good Standing or higher are the only communities eligible for Keep Texas Beautiful pass through grants, Don't Mess with Texas collateral for litter prevention events, bonus incentive items for Great American Cleanup/ Don't Mess with Texas Trash-Off, and ability to apply for a scholarship to

the KTB conference. It is also an important requirement for Keep America Beautiful certification. Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful is currently meeting KAB requirements. Again, very impressive for a first-year city.

Finally, Keep Texas Beautiful announced that Weston Lakes' resident, Carol Fairbanks won the top honor of Volunteer of the Year for the State of Texas. The Volunteer of the Year Award recognizes the single individual in the State of Texas who, during 2017, supported the mission of KTB through extraordinary efforts and contributed to the betterment of their community.

Honorees will receive their awards at the Keep Texas Beautiful Annual Awards Meeting, June 11th through 13th, in Georgetown, Texas.

Vaterside Grill DID YOU KNOW? With so many new residents and golf members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain our food and beverage service charge policy. Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait stuff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public. the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that particular table as a tip. However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage. In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times. All our servers are paid an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this charge in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience.
