

Golf Course Maintenance




he hot days of August are behind us, and the maintenance staff is looking forward to cooler days in September and October. September should be a great month for golf! We will have the club championships, and the greens should be in great condition. We will start to lower the rough to its original height when the temperatures start to cool down. I know the longer rough has been an issue through August. The reason we raised the height was to insure the quality of the turf during the hotter months.

We appreciate the compliments we have been receiving on the quality of the golf course. As I make my way around the course I have noticed a considerable amount of divots not being repaired on the greens. This is unfair to the players who do repair their ball marks. If you hit your ball on the green, there will be a ball mark and if you can't find it, please repair one that you do see. An unrepaired ball mark takes two weeks to heal, a repaired ball mark only takes three days to heal. Thank you for your help with this issue.

We will not be overseeding greens this year so we can do a better job of week control and not have any issues with the greens during the spring when we normally have transition. Hope to see you on the course and as always please repair your ball marks and sand your divots.

ome of you may be aware that our streets took quite a beating from the Harvey flooding. One of the main reasons is the foundation under the streets became saturated and stayed that way for an extended period of time because the street slope to the ditch was not operating as originally designed. As a result, much of the runoff was not getting to the ditches as designed. If left as is, this will eventually cause the streets to fail prematurely and require that they be totally replaced at a great expense. To prolong the life of our streets we need to perform preventive maintenance on the slope by reestablishing their original designed grade. Unfortunately, this means the slope leading to the ditches, which is in the Right of Way (ROW) of the streets will be disturbed, You might believe that this area is part of your yard, but the ROW is actually a part of the Street. Although the Architectural Bulletin warns against it, many of you may have established landscaping, sprinkler heads and other improvements in this area. These improvements in the Street ROW may/will be destroyed if not relocated before the grading is performed.

Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful, in an effort to become a "Tree City USA" community, announces our new **Tribute Tree Program**. This program allows residents to purchase a Tribute Tree that will be a lasting gift that will grow more beautiful every year.

Working with the Weston Lakes POA and club management, Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful has identified several locations on public areas throughout our community, including the golf course, where trees can be planted and would enhance our community, as well as help with erosion. Also, following the historic precedent that began many years ago by the Men's Golf Asociation to honor their members who had passed, additional trees can be added to the golf course with approval of our Golf Course Superintendent. Trees can also be planted on private lawns should you prefer to give a gift to a friend.

Soil samples will be taken and sent to Texas A&M to be evaluated before planting, and Live Oaks will be planted in public areas such as Hwy 1093 frontage, entries to all gates, and in parks. Crepe Myrtles and other varieties will also be available. Water or irrigation is necessary for some chosen tree sites. Planting will begin in late October or November.

Tribute Tree prices will include the 15, 30 or 65-gallon trees, fully customized 12x6-inch engraved black granite marker with your choice of verbiage, planting and mulch. Prices vary according to type and size of tree you purchase ranging from \$200.00 to \$525.00.

The Texas Historical Commission (THC) or other state agencies do not enforce cemetery laws. This responsibility belongs to county and municipal law enforcement agencies. If you are aware of cemetery vandalism or desecration contact your county sheriff or local police department.

Protection of historic cemeteries is, however, a shared responsibility. Notification must be made to protect these irreplaceable cultural resources. Cemetery desecration is a continuing problem in Texas and throughout the United States. Destruction occurs in many ways, including the illegal removal of human remains, damage from roaming livestock, encroaching development and construction, vandalism, and theft of grave goods and funerary objects. State laws exist to protect cemeteries from vandalism, theft and desecration.

Section 28.03(f) of the Texas Penal Code, Criminal Mischief, provides that an offense involving damage or destruction inflicted on a human burial site is a state jail felony.
