


Golf Course Maintenance

Daily Park Dedication Community Invitation

Community invited to help dedicate new park on October 6, SIMONTON, TX

Two years ago, along with his wife, Joyce, and daughter, Laura, Dr. Harold Daily of Houston donated more than 68 acres of land for a park in north Fort Bend County. A native of Simonton, Dr. Daily provided the land for the specific purpose of establishing a park and nature preserve to a rapidly-growing county in need of recreational and green space. The park will be officially named the Abe and Lizzie Daily Park in honor of Dr. Daily's parents.

According to Fort Bend County officials, plans for the park include at least four baseball diamonds, two soccer fields and a nature preserve along land bordering the Brazos River.

On Saturday, October 6, members of the community are invited to join the Daily family for the official dedication of the Abe & Lizzie Daily Park. The ceremony will take place at 11 a.m. at 4026 Nails

Road, Simonton. There will be a short presentation followed by light refreshments.

Abe and Lizzie Daily emigrated from Eastern Europe in the early 1900s in order to escape persecution and have a better life in America. They married in 1915 and lived in Simonton, where Abe farmed the land and operated the Daily Brothers General Store. Abe and Lizzie Daily raised five children, Sylvia, Robbie, Harold, Abe Jr. and Dorothy in Simonton and were known throughout the area for their kindness and generosity to those in need.

Four generations of the Daily family will be on hand for the event. The family hopes that members of the community will join them on Saturday, October 6.

Keep Texas Beautiful (KTB) founded the Rebuilding Texas Fund in August, 2017 to support its affiliate communities impacted by Hurricane Harvey. With contributions from Revolver Brewing, Waste Management and Chevron, as well as generous individual donors, KTB created the Rebuilding Texas Grants Program to support restoration projects and long-term recovery efforts in the affected communities. Monarch Butterfly Waystation

Pecan Park has been chosen as the location for the new Monarch Butterfly Waystation. This project is designed and modeled after many such projects located throughout the United States to attract butterflies by planting a specific area of a park with plants, trees and flowers known to allure these beautiful lepidopterans.
