



2019 USGA and R&A Rule Changes

Before we get too far into this article, it is important to understand the new USGA and RA rules of golf for 2019. Here is a summary from the USGA web site:

The main changes to the Rules of Golf are for reference. These are the changes expected to have the most impact on the game and to be of most interest to golfers and those who follow the game.

- . Ball at rest, ball moved, and ball replaced
- Ball in motion, accidental deflection and double hit
- Taking relief, dropping procedure, lost ball, substituted ball and embedded ball
- · Areas of the course, putting green and penalty areas bunkers
- Equipment, damaged clubs and other equipment
- Playing a ball, advice and help
- · When to play during a round and pace of play
- · Player behavior, standards of conduct and integrity

It is incumbent on every player to take the time to read the new rules of golf for 2019. A summary of the rules will be available in the 19th Hole.

Etiquette

Over the next few months, we'll discuss golf etiquette. First out of box is respect.

Respect for the course - leave the course as you would like to find it by repairing pitch-marks, replacing divots and raking bunkers

Respect for your fellow players - be sportsmanlike and polite, stay by the green to watch them hole out, and avoid distracting them

Respect for the game - by knowing the Rules and etiquette of golf

s the cold weather rapidly approaches, remember to prepare your home and sprinkler system. Be sure to cover all outdoor valves with insulation. Turn off your sprinkler system and open the valve bleeds. Turn off and drain any water hoses. Insulate pipes that are exposed. Make sure your heater works properly before you need it. This will give time for a repair man to come before it gets too cold in your home. If needed, set a faucet to a slow drip (from both hot and cold side) to keep the water moving in your pipes. Lastly, make sure you know where your homes main water valve is, and make sure it is accessible (clear of mud, water, snakes or spiders) and that you have the proper tool in order to turn the valve on/off.

We would like to recognize all the volunteers working with Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful. Their efforts at the Cemetery, Pecan Park and the front entrance continue to improve and beautify our surroundings. The Tribute Tree program is an on-going project that will bring years of beauty to our community.

The conversion of our street lights to LED continues. Beginning mid-December CenterPoint will continue the conversion in Riverwood, Fairway Villas and Oxbow.

Please remember that the Winding Stream gate is for Residents Only. All Visitors, Guests, Contractors, Friends, and Relatives MUST use the Main front entry AND be issued a pass.

A new website and entry procedures are under development.

Asset Monitoring Camera installation began on November 20th.

The New Gatehouse is scheduled to open around Christmas.


