2019 Rules of Golf

In January, Cliff Bottoms and Keith Simmons presented the new rules of golf for 2019. This was a very informative event where many LGA, SMGA and MGA members attended.

The WLMGA has adopted the local rule on balls out of bounds or out of play. The MGA also adopted a (local) root rule. For the root rule, relief from an exposed root is one grip length no closer to the hole. If the relief does not allow for a swing, then a drop and one stroke penalty applies. Both rules are in effect for NON-tournament play days.

Upcoming MGA event

The next MGA event is the Member-Member tournament on March 23rd.

Etiquette

Last month was the final installment for Respect for the Course. This month's etiquette topic is respect for your fellow players. This means being a gentleman and sportsman. In Rule 1.2 of the USGA/RA Rules of Golf requires players to act with integrity, show consideration for others, and take care of the course. What are some of the elements for showing respect and consideration for others on the tee-box, fairway and putting surface?

- General rule for all locations on the course: respect other players play when they are about to hit or putt; keep quiet and still.
- Unless in a tournament, there are only "local" rules for the players' order when teeing off.
- The player furthest away (from the green) in the managed area goes first. There are caveats to that rule: **ready golf**. Example: during cart path only play, my partner's ball is in the fairway close to the cart path and my ball is further back on the fairway but on the opposite side. There is no reason my partner cannot play before me instead of waiting for me to get to my ball and play. Suggestion: before teeing off, agree on ready golf etiquette with your fellow players.
- Use the 40-second rule: once at your ball, you should take no more than 40 second to play your ball. This speeds up play.
- Speaking of speed: allow faster groups to play through your group.
- Around the green, those furthest away from the pin go first. A player on the fringe close to the hole may offer another player on the green to go first. With the new pin (flag stick) rule, the player furthest away typically goes first. Those closest to the pin go last and the order may change.
- Four words you never want to hear on a putting surface: you are still away.
- The first one who holes out replaces the pin if it is out.
- Never cast a shadow in the line of a player's putt.
- Never stand behind a player or on the player's line from the other side of the pin.
- Never spit on a green.
- Leave your clubs off the green, on the fringe, but in line with your golf cart so you won't forget them after completing the hole.
- Never walk off the green while other players are putting.

Living with and using these simple rules of etiquette will make your game more enjoyable and fun.

SMGA UPDATE

We want to welcome new SMGA members **Jesse Fontenot** and **Ken Tucker**. Jesse joined the SMGA at the January 17th play day. Ken joined the SMGA at the February 14th play day. Welcome Jesse and Ken. In the event you haven't paid your 2019 SMGA dues, please do so soon as possible. You can give your 2019 Dues (cash or check) to **Dan Bishop**, any SMGA Board member, or leave it in the Pro Shop in the SMGA wicker basket above the Handicap Computer. Please include your name and SMGA 2019 Dues on the envelope.

SMGA Play Days

The SMGA has "Play Days" each Tuesday and Thursday morning. Members playing arrive at the driving range area and are signed in by 8:30 a.m. to play that day. The SMGA utilizes a computer program developed by member **Terry Miller** to randomly draw the teams each day. The members playing regularly with the SMGA have handicaps ranging from 6 - 32. Each player contributes \$5.00 to the pot. The format varies each play day, including Stroke Play games and Stableford formats. Stroke Games include; 2 out of 4, 2 out of 4 with 3 on the par 5's, 1 out of 4, 1 out of 4 with carryovers (bonuses), 2 out of 4 - 1 gross and 1 net, 3 out of 4 - 1 gross and 2 net, 2 out of 4 with 3 on the Par 4's. Stableford Games include; 5 out of 8, 12 out of 18 (6 on each 9) and 13 out of 18.

Payouts each play day also include Closest to the Pin on the four Par 3's. This includes one payout for the members playing the Gold Tees and one for the members playing the Red Tees. The SMGA utilizes a shotgun start each day, with teams beginning on holes 14 - 18 and number 1. Those 55 years and older are welcome to come and join us. We look forward to meeting you.

Interclub Association

The Weston Lakes SMGA is a member of the Westside Senior Interclub Golf Association. There are eight clubs in the league for 2019, with tournament play beginning in March. Member Golf Clubs include: The Club at Falcon Point, Fort Bend Country Club, Pecan Grove Plantation Country Club, Quail Valley Golf Course, Sugar Creek Country Club, Sweetwater Country Club, Willow Fork Country Club and Weston Lakes Country Club. Each club will host a match this year with the first hosted by Pecan Grove Plantation Country Club. Weston Lakes Country Club will host a match in late April. The league does not schedule play in July and August with the last match of the year in November. Each club sends eight players to each match. The teams play each match utilizing a Modified Stableford scoring system. Each team score is comprised of the best five scores from the eight players. The entry fee for each player includes green fees, cart rental, practice balls, prize money and a meal after the match.
