

From the Golf Shop









Left - Dennis Ayers 1st career Hole In One Right - Charles Wisdom 3 strokes under his age of 81

hanksgiving is right around the corner, and more often than not, it's the time of year that weight tends to fluctuate and healthy habits are kicked to the curb! Holiday season is the toughest time of the year to stay on track with your Fitness Goals because everything is centered on food . . . and LOTS of it! Here are five tips and tricks to help you stay on track through the Holidays!

1. Fit it all on one plate. Prevent over-stuffing yourself by fitting your Thanksgiving feast all on one plate (This works best if you don't use an oversized plate filled to the brim). Sample small portions and avoid going back for seconds. If you're tempted to return for more, give yourself 20 minutes (about how long it takes to feel full) first.

2. Eat slowly. Thanksgiving foods are likely to be richer and more filling than your everyday fare, so eat slowly and savor every bite.

3. Enjoy the company of family and friends. Socialize during your meal and festivities. You can't eat and talk at the same time – so the more conversation you enjoy, the less you'll eat.

4. Get moving. Sign up for a local Turkey Trot 5K or 10K and spend

your Thanksgiving morning getting some exercise. Not only will you burn some calories, but you'll also enjoy some holiday fun!

5. Make some easy Turkey day substitutions. For example:

Eat the white meat without the skin instead of the dark meat with skin and shave off 190 calories.

Turkey – white meat, no skin (60z): 180 calories, 3g fat Turkey – dark meat, with skin (60z): 370 calories, 20g fat


Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful



t's hard to believe that we are closing in on another year gone by! First of all... Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful and all its volunteer members wish all of you and your families a wonderful and joyous Thanksgiving!

Once again, Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful, along with our great community of volunteers, demonstrated that environmental stewardship is everyone's responsibility and came together in Pecan Park, Waterford, and The Villa's for the annual "Fall Sweep" event. This community-wide cleanup resulted in collecting over 1500 pounds of debris, 50 pounds of recyclable, trimming Magnolias, new plants and shrubs, and over 270 volunteer hours.

Last year Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful, as a recipient of the prestigious Rebuilding Texas Grant, it gave us a great start toward improving Pecan Park. We continued this year by planting three new 65-gallon Laurel Oaks, over 300 bulbs, and clearing the surrounding brush to help our Monarch Butterflies thrive in the migration process.



At Waterford, new plants

were added to the entrance and to the small butterfly garden that resides there. The Villa's entrance received some maintenance as well, with the magnolia trees trimmed and the area weeded and mulched. All these activities help the make our community just a little better.

As always, we are continually reaching out for volunteer's and this an excellent way for students to earn volunteer hours and get involved in their neighborhood activities and was a great opportunity to show our community strength and pride. I remind you, that Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful is a volunteer effort to improve our city and receives no financial aid from the city, the POA or MUD. We are simply a group of neighborhood volunteers that rely on the generous donations of volunteerism and the money from our residents and local businesses. Our only goal is to improve our neighborhood and property values through education, beautification, recycling and volunteerism.

Don't Be A Litter Bug and Don't Mess With Texas!

"The Bobs" (Babes on Bikes) cycling club of Weston Lakes and Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful, participated in the TxDot Adopt-A-Highway program picking up litter along the two miles of FM 1093 in front of Weston Lakes for approximately three hours on October 12th and ended with a few enjoying a late breakfast at Ropers. 12 volunteers collected over 500 pounds of litter!

Did you know?

- Approximately 435 Million pieces of visible litter accumulate on Texas roadways each year!!
- ■71% of litter is microliter that is not easily seen on roadways.

As we strive to win the Governor's Community Achievement award from TxDot for the year ended 2019, we know that our projects must stand out among the other cities vying for this same prestigious award, and this year we are stepping out of our "comfort zone" with an innovative solution to increasing the tree population in Weston Lakes.

Traditionally, French Drains are used to carry water away from foundations, but we used this old school technology to distribute water "to" our newly planted Live Oaks along the Pecan waterway. With no source of electricity for an irrigation system we used "Water Runs" into a gravel-filled trench, then into perforated pipe at the bottom of the trench. Water travels freely through the pipe and distributes water to the trees. Once the trees are established, the pipes are capped off and we have happy, healthy thriving trees. A big thank you to Arbor Guardian for this ingenious idea!






