

After years of stressing over the holidays trying to "do it all" with three young sons, work, decorating, social engagements, gift buying, etc., I made a conscious decision to view Christmas as a journey, not a destination. The older I get, the more I realize that regardless of the time of year, time spent with family and friends is THE most important part of life in general especially during the holidays. What does this have to do with the garden club you may ask. Well...on December 19th the garden club is partnering with the WLWA for our Christmas Dinner Dance. Our first freeze is upon us as I write this. Below is some information from the Houston Chronicle about protecting your potted plants:

WATER: If rain has missed your garden, water. Move potted tender plants indoors, including tropical hibiscus, plumeria, young or tropical fruit trees and bromeliads.

MULCH: Give your plants a "blanket" of mulch. Together with moist soil, this helps protect their roots.

PROVIDE COVER: Many shrubs, trees and winter annuals tolerate cold, but to try to save blooms, cover flowering azaleas, camellias and fruit trees with row cover, sheets or blankets.

AFTER A FREEZE: Do not wash frost/ice off plants the morning after a freeze.

Other than moving plants inside, all of the above precautions apply to our shrubs and bedding plants. Since many of us have extensive landscaping, it may be almost impossible to cover everything which is stressful! My suggestion is to stay indoors, have a cup of hot chocolate or a glass of wine or two and accept that sometimes Mother Nature wins.

I hope to see you at our Christmas dinner/dance, and I wish that all the blessings of the Christmas season illuminate your holidays with love and good cheer!

Coming up: January 8th (weather permitting) our Ice Breaker Scramble. Lunch afterwards and first meeting of the year.





Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful

REE CITY USA PROUD

"He who plants a tree plants hope"

Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful (KWLB) and the city of Weston Lakes are proud to have worked diligently and ultimately achieved the status of Tree City USA. Nationwide, there are 3,400 cities that have achieved this recognition, but in Texas our little City stands out as one of only 88 Texas Cities to receive the honor and one of the four smallest. We can now proudly fly our Tree City U.S.A. flag all year long and make our Weston Lakes citizens feel good about the place they live and work. This is KWLB at work for all of us!

The distinction of being a Tree City USA involves meeting four core standards of good and sustainable urban forest management. A good working relationship between our designated Tree Board and the governing officials of the City, POA, MUD 81, and our community developer is necessary to attain this distinction and to be certain that trees on public property are properly planted and maintained to enhance the continued beauty of Weston Lakes. This is KWLB's goal and it takes ALL the above-mentioned entities to attain this award to such a small community.

Also required however, is creating a Community Tree Ordinance on public areas and KWLB worked relentlessly with the city of Weston Lakes to achieve this. After great effort and defense of our intentions, the city of Weston Lakes ultimately passed an ordinance last year to this effect. The third requirement is that a city must spend at least \$2.00 per resident on urban forestry. This includes planting new trees, removal of trees that are damaged, pruning trees, mulching, and the cost of labor and machinery required to perform the maintenance.in public areas. The fourth requirement is for the City Mayor to proclaim Texas Arbor Day in our City and have an Arbor Day Celebration. The cities governing entities must provide KWLB with the statistics necessary to complete the application to The Arbor Day Foundation each year to remain a Tree City USA, so we encourage each of you to remind our elected officials of the importance of this designation and to support KWLB so that Weston Lakes does not lose this designation in future years after our hard work to achieve it.

KWLB would like to thank the City officials, the POA and Mr. Mike Surface for their continued support and working closely with Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful this year. We have fulfilled all the requirements and we could not have accomplished this for Weston Lakes, without them. We are also thankful to all the Weston Lakes residents who have planted trees on their private property and advised KWLB which is VERY IMPORTANT for inclusion in our annual report, and those who attended the Arbor Day Celebration.

The Tribute Tree program continues to be one of KWLB's most successful new programs and we hope even more

residents, organizations and businesses will pay tribute to someone they love, living or deceased, and honor them by planting a tree to recognize their contributions or achievements. Since the program began last year, 84 Tribute Trees have been planted as of this report. Many more are needed on the golf course, in our parks and other public areas. KWLB also prepares plagues, optionally, at the base of the trees to place into words your gratitude as a sponsor. What better tribute can one provide than a living tree with your words of love and thankfulness.

Finally, as a reminder, we would also like to ask all the homeowners who have had your trees trimmed this year, to send us an email to: keepwestonlakesbeautiful@gmail.com advising us of the date and cost of such activity. Our city gets recognition for this toward our Tree City designation, but if we don't know about it, we can't count it! It is a gift you can give your city and your trees that will pay future dividends.

Club on November 1st came away with both practical and enlightening information about the importance of urban forest management in cities like Weston Lakes. While attending the event sponsored by Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful (KWLB) and the City of Weston Lakes, they learned that while our local environment is NOT usually damaged due to loss of trees since our gulf coast

environment is plentiful in oxygen generating flora and fauna, that is not the case nationwide. They also learned that the introduction of new trees (like KWLB's tree tribute program) is both environmentally beneficial and esthetically appealing to improve the environment and overall property value. Mayor Mary Rose Zdundewicz began the program by reading the official Proclamation declaring November 1st as official Texas Arbor Day in Weston Lakes. Last year OUR City was honored by being named a Tree City USA after extensive efforts and lobbying to National, State and our local governments about the VALUE of this designation. Michael Merritt, Regional Forester and certified Arborist from Texas A&M Texas Forest Service explained the importance of the Tree City USA designation. For the first time, our Tree City USA flag was flown from the flagpole. Shawn Geiman, a certified Arborist trained in tree risk assessment and owner of Shawnee Trees spoke on proper tree maintenance and conducted a well-received question and answer session. Terri Oliver conducted The Arbor Day Tree dedication which this year involved a Tribute Tree that residents purchased and planted in honor of Mr. Louis Butler. Terri had initiated the idea of raising funds for the tree and it had great community support. The beautiful Laurel Oak is located along FM 1093 next to the Information Center. Thanks to ALL who donated. This activity is an act of kindness and respect and it separates Weston Lakes from other cities with this designation as compassionate and caring and KWLB is forever appreciative. Additionally, a very special thank you to Katelyn Gray and staff for allowing us to move the program into the ballroom at the last minute due to weather. Also, thanks to KWLB Tree Board members Nancy Case, Carolyn Martinez and Jamie Johnson who greeted and hosted the event, and Jean Lobo, our talented photographer. Finally, our thanks to the POA for allowing KWLB to post the Tree City USA flag for Arbor Day.
