

#### **Mayor's Comments**

n behalf of Weston Lakes City Government, we would like to announce Weston Lakes new leased office for City Hall is open for business. We would like to welcome you to stop by when you are in downtown Fulshear. Our address is: 8045 FM-359, Suite 200, Fulshear, Texas, 77441. Our office is in Fulshear Professional Park, located next to the Post Office. While our address has changed, our phone number remains the same: (281) 533-0907. Hope you stop by!

As you all know, development is coming our way. Recently, in an informative meeting with Alex Hunt, I learned in LCISD that our schools have an "A" rating, and we have approximately 35,000 children in the school district. In the next 10 years, that number is projected to increase to 60,000 with this growth stemming from mainly Weston Lakes, Twinwood in Simonton, and Polo Ranch.

A new elementary school will be built near Polo Ranch, another near Jordan Ranch, and a new elementary school is being built in Tamarron. This is greatly needed because Huggins Elementary has a capacity of 650 and is serving 900.

This new elementary school to be built near Polo Ranch may change where our children attend elementary school. It is expected to have students attending it in the near future. The land has not been purchased, but it was decided it will be in this area. It is important to note, the elementary school will have an impact on traffic on 1093.

Please visit LCISD website to learn more. Particularly, look up PASA, which shows the numbers in our region, projected growth, demographics and maps of our area.

Alex Hunt will be attending our city council meeting at the Country Club on February 25, 2020, at 6 p.m. We look forward to seeing you there!

#### **Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful**

#### overnor's Community Achievement Award.

Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful collects data for activities and accomplishments during the prior calendar year that goes toward qualifying for the Keep Texas Beautiful grant. This data includes the activities, events and measurable improvements involved in qualified beautification, education, environmental protection, recycling and volunteerism. In addition, this data includes the measurement of quantities of planting of trees, bushes and plants. It also included items and quantities of adding mulch to your beds. This data is for the entire city and all the homes, private property and public property, so accumulating this information from residents is critical to accurately reporting our efforts to Keep Texas Beautiful.

Tree City USA data reporting, which is also a part of the information that KWLB collects, includes the number of trees planted and the work (in number of hours) you may have done during the past year, trimming your trees and raking leaves. We have seen many yard crews trimming trees and doing fall cleanup, as well as, installation of new landscapes and fall flower planting. This data can include not only your fall yard work, but any such work performed, by you or your yard/landscaping crews, during the year. It only takes a few minutes of your time to help us by reporting to us your annual activity, but it can make a huge contribution toward our KWLB goals and our opportunity to win the award!



For more than 30 years, Keep Texas Beautiful, in partnership with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), has awarded the prestigious Governor's Community Achievement Awards to Texas communities for their outstanding overall efforts to keep their communities beautiful.

Ten winning communities will share \$2 million in landscaping awards from the Texas Department of Transportation, with the amount based on population size. Because of the growth of Weston Lakes during the last year, we will move up into category II, for cities with a population of 3,001 – 5,500, with the landscape award amount of \$110,000. The grant funds are required to be used for landscaping projects along local rights-of-way.

A community's environmental program is judged on achievements in seven areas:

- Community Leadership and Coordination
- Public Awareness and Outreach
- Environmental Education
- · Beautification and Community Improvement
- Litter Prevention and Cleanup
- Solid Waste Management
- Litter Law and Illegal Dumping Enforcement

Thank you in advance for your participation! All of your data is needed by February 10 in order to be included in our 2019 totals for the grant. We can improve our community with this money, which we expect would include appreciation of home values, as this has been our goal since starting this journey three years ago. We encourage all of you to quickly compose emails to: keepwestonlakesbeautiful@gmail. com briefly describing the number or plants, bushes, trees planted, pounds/bags of mulch, etc. and the estimated amount of hours spent during the year by you or your yard workers on the above types of projects. #### Orange Bag Reminder!

Simply Recycling comes to Weston Lakes every Wednesday (rain or shine) to pick up your qualified recycling material which includes clothing, shoes and household discards (like small appliances, bedding, toys, towels, kitchenware, etc.). This service is not intended for recycling paper or plastics like you normally leave for the local trash service. Simply place your Simply Recycling bag out at your curbside on any Wednesday and POOF! It will be gone. THIS COST NOTHING to you or Weston Lakes, but the best part is, based on volume, Simply Recycling will give money back to our community for Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful projects. This is an easy way to support Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful, beautify Weston Lakes and improve our environment by keeping these materials out of our landfills.

Simple Recycling has been supportive of the KWLB mission by supplying a unique, free diversion method for the fastest growing part of residential waste streams. Clothes recycling is going curbside in more U.S. towns as global prices rise for the used apparel, shoes and linens that most Americans often toss in the trash. 
#### **Golf Course Maintenance**






