
# Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful

**K** eep Weston Lakes Beautiful is proud to announce the winners of the Art Contest



**Aubrie Richter**, age 12. Her artwork is titled “Bucks Night Out at Firefly Meadow.”





4) Is there someone you feel shaped your life in some way by motivation or inspiration and, if so, who comes to mind and what did they say or do that moved you?

My life was shaped mostly by my father, who always said "believe in the goodness of people, until they prove themselves otherwise."

I have to agree with Nandita's wise father and that it a great policy for all of us to follow!
