





Here are five tips and tricks to help you stay on track through the Holidays!

- If it it all on one plate. Prevent over-stuffing yourself by fitting your Thanksgiving feast all on one plate (This works best if you don't use an oversized plate filled to the brim). Sample small portions and avoid going back for seconds. If you're tempted to return for more, give yourself 20 minutes (about how long it takes to feel full) first.
- Eat slowly. Thanksgiving foods are likely to be richer and more filling than your everyday fare, so eat slowly and savor every bite.
- Enjoy the company of family and friends. Socialize during your meal and festivities. You can't eat and talk at the same time ~ so the more conversation you enjoy, the less you'll eat.
- Get moving. Sign up for a local Turkey Trot 5K or 10K and spend your Thanksgiving morning getting some exercise. Not only will you burn some calories, but you'll also enjoy some holiday fun!
- Make some easy Turkey day substitutions. For example: Eat the white meat without the skin instead of the dark meat with skin and shave off 190 calories.

Turkey – white meat, no skin (602): 180 calories, 3g fat Turkey - dark meat, with skin (602): 370 calories, 20g fat By Natalie Digate Muth, MD, MPH, RD.

Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful

t is always sad when we have to say goodbye to one of our majestic trees, and it is never done without much thorough research. Just like humans, trees also have a life cycle, well beyond ours, but unfortunately when trees reach that time, they become a significant danger, with a risk of falling or dropping life threatening limbs. Better to respectfully remove our ancients rather than it take a life, paralyze an individual, crush a car or something else. It is never an easy decision, but appropriate action must always be taken to mitigate this risk. Our trees at the Weston Lakes front gate, that have recently lost limbs, have been expertly evaluated, and they must soon be replaced.

KWLB looks forward to using our TxDot grant money to replace, and add to, those wonderful Pecan and Live Oaks that have graced us with their beauty along FM1093 for many decades. This is an exciting time for us, and we will keep our community up to date with progress and timeline.

Did you know?

The Pecan is the Texas state tree, being native to about 150 counties and capable of growing and producing in all Texas counties. The tree is popular for landscaping and as a source of nuts. Proper attention to cultural requirements and pest control help to assure a long and productive life for our enjoyment and also for our furry friends.

What is the life cycle and life span of an oak tree?

Insect infestation, disease, scavenging animals and adverse weather conditions can prematurely end the life cycle at any stage. In the best of circumstances these native trees can live for almost 100 years. Our trees near the gate were part of the plantation and were preserved, as a number of others, when Weston Lakes was first created almost five decades ago.


With over 180 native species of oak trees in the United States alone, there is an oak species for virtually any climate or growing condition. Average life span for most oak species is between 100 to 300 years, though the known maximum life span for several species well exceeds the averages.

Live oak diseases come in many forms. Oak wilt is a fungal infection that affects all oak trees, including live oaks. Root rot, powdery mildew, oak bark beetles and oak beetles also can create serious problems for your live oak tree.
