



You can also filter by division, flight and tees. Guess which hole had the fewest birdies. Another spoiler, #5 had the most birdies in 2020.



elcome to February!

The shortest month of the year is best known for Valentine's Day on February 14th. However, in our neck of the Zone 9 woods, February is a bit fickle (like some of our Valentines) and is also transitional weather wise. Since we don't really have defined seasons, it's a bit more confusing as to when to do what as opposed to our Northern neighbors. It's not that unusual to have a winter that is virtually freeze free, only to have a late hard freeze towards the end of February or in early March. However, it is a great time to plan. For those that may be new to our area or perhaps taking a new interest in gardening, it's a good time to do some reading regarding Zone 9. One rule to keep in mind early on is that trees and shrubs do best planted before our Texas heat sets in. Last year, your WLGC had a presentation about using worm castings to enrich/fertilize the soil in pots and for in-ground planting. The gentleman who owns the Magic Worm Ranch up in Plantersville (north of Tomball) came out, and I bought some of the castings he brought with him so I could try them out. I was amazed by the results. My existing potted plants grew to twice the size and were much more lush with exemplary flowers. To be perfectly honest, I saw the announcement about that presentation and thought it sounded a tad bizarre. I am so glad that I did attend that meeting!



This year, our February presentation is on Tuesday, the 23rd:

Andy Chidester from Fox Farms will have a presentation on using organic soil and fertilizer in your garden. Everything from bed prep to fertilization and even pest control will be covered. Enchanted Gardens (one of my favorites!) will be sponsoring this event with some large door prizes.

Great news that many home improvements are happening in Weston Lakes. Reminder that all exterior home improvements and additions must be approved by the Architectural Control Committee. An agreement signed with Amazon provides greater accountability and tracking of Amazon drivers. It also allows quicker access for deliveries to residents near the East gate and in Waterford, where Amazon drivers can open the gates by using a secure Amazon phone app. The question was raised whether this meant we are sacrificing security. The answer is no, the same level of restricted access exists, simply via a different process, which is fully trackable.

Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful

hat is Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful (KWLB)?

Like many aspects of our very unique city, it might be confusing what KWLB is. Is it a club like the Garden Club? Is it part of the City government or the Property Owners Association (POA)? Who is the membership? Why does it exist and what does it do? Here's a quick primer.

At the foundational level, KWLB is an affiliate of Keep Texas Beautiful (KTB). KTB's history dates back to 1967, when Texas was preparing for the 1968 HemisFair in San Antonio. More than 16 million tourists were expected to descend upon the state, and it was then known as the Beautify Texas Council. When the impact of volunteers throughout the state and the pride in local communities was realized, the program continued and later became Keep Texas Beautiful, an affiliate of Keep America Beautiful.

KWLB is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization and works closely with the City and the POA. It is a network of volunteers within the community that includes individuals and community organizations. Did you plant a tree this year? Did you recycle? Did you pick up a piece of trash on the street? Did your organization discuss native plants? Is your yard bird friendly? Yes? Then you contributed to KWLB's mission!

KWLB is coordinated by a Board of Directors established by its bylaws. Why do we need additional volunteers and what do volunteers do? Volunteers make everything possible. A few examples:

- · Building/maintaining the butterfly garden in Pecan Park;
- Refurbishing/maintaining the historical cemetery behind Riverwood Park;
- Maintaining public Adopta-Spot areas at the entrances to Oxbow Island and The Village;
- · Highway trash clean-up;
- Arbor Day tree planting;
- Achieving the Governor's Community Achievement Award resulting in funding to plant trees along 1093 in front of Weston Lakes;
- · Kid's Fish educational and fun programs;
- · Educational Bird Program for kids;
- Recycling events including shredding events and the Orange Bag program;
- Fund raising to support the events and programs.

Four hours of formal Strategic Planning conducted by the KWLB Board in January will help ensure we are meeting the unique needs of our community, continuing our mission, and establishing a calendar of events and programs for 2021. We are creating a roster of volunteers and look forward to working with many of you! 

Mayor's Comments appy Valentine's Day!

The 87th legislative session began on January 12, 2021. It will be historic as the first to take place during a pandemic and actually addressing the pandemic. Among many other bills, they will be working with a tight state budget and redistricting this year, which includes redrawing political maps due to the 2020 census. There are many issues from the racial injustice demonstrations during the summer to dealing with the topic of vaccinations. Much work is ahead of our legislators this year. I serve as Texas Municipal Leagues Delegate for the 2021 Summit.

The City of Weston Lakes signed up with FBC Health & Human Services to be a possible site for vaccinations to occur. We will be partnering with FBC Health & Human Services to make this happen. Since we do not own any property, we may be assigned to work with another city. Please visit the Texas Department of State Health Services at https://www.dshs.state.tx.us/ to learn about the current phases in vaccinations and to find providers offering the vaccine. Right now, we are still in Phase 1a and 1b. Those who are over 65 years or older and/or with a chronic medical condition that puts them at increased risk are eligible to receive the vaccine (1b). Over one million people have been vaccinated in the State of Texas thus far.

We are experiencing higher numbers of positive tests, as has been evidenced by our governor's executive orders and the lowering of the percentages of people allowed in restaurants and allowed to gather at this time. We are expecting the apex to be reached at the end of January and hopefully, numbers will once again lessen.
