The Golf Shop will remain open, and the target date to reopen the Fitness Center has changed due to the holidays to March 1, 2021 or sooner.



ELECTION: The annual meeting of the Weston Lakes POA was held virtually on December 3, 2020. The election of three Board Members and two Architectural Control Committee (ACC) Members was concluded. Elected for two-year terms are for the Board: Jane Poe, Rhea Ragle, and Joyce Tipton; and for the ACC: Jason Beal and Velda Faulkner. The amendment to the Articles of Incorporation passed by an overwhelming majority.

GATES: New gate software is up and running! This system is cloud based and more reliable than the previous server. If the internet goes down, the site controllers keep a complete backup on them so there will be no interruption. The system comes with a phone app that allows property owners to quickly and easily update their guest information. We have new cameras on the East Gate, and installation of cameras at Riverwood Park will be completed this month.

LAKES: Several property owners along the lakes have requested that the bank along their property not be sprayed to slow erosion and facilitate habitat for fish and food for birds. A process is in the works to provide flags for placement on property lines to avoid spraying of requested areas.
