Golf Course Maintenance



We had some historically low temperatures in February, which could delay our spring green-up by a few weeks. We watered the greens heavy to insulate them before the multiple days of below freezing temperatures. We will be able to assess if there is any damage to the greens over the next four to six weeks when we start having warmer temperatures. The cart path project has started at 7 & 16 restroom, snack bar, and greens. We will be diverting cart traffic around the construction site, so please do not cross the ropes in your carts. We will keep the restrooms open and we will lay a plywood walkway for temporary use. As always, please repair your ball marks on the greens and sand your divots.
