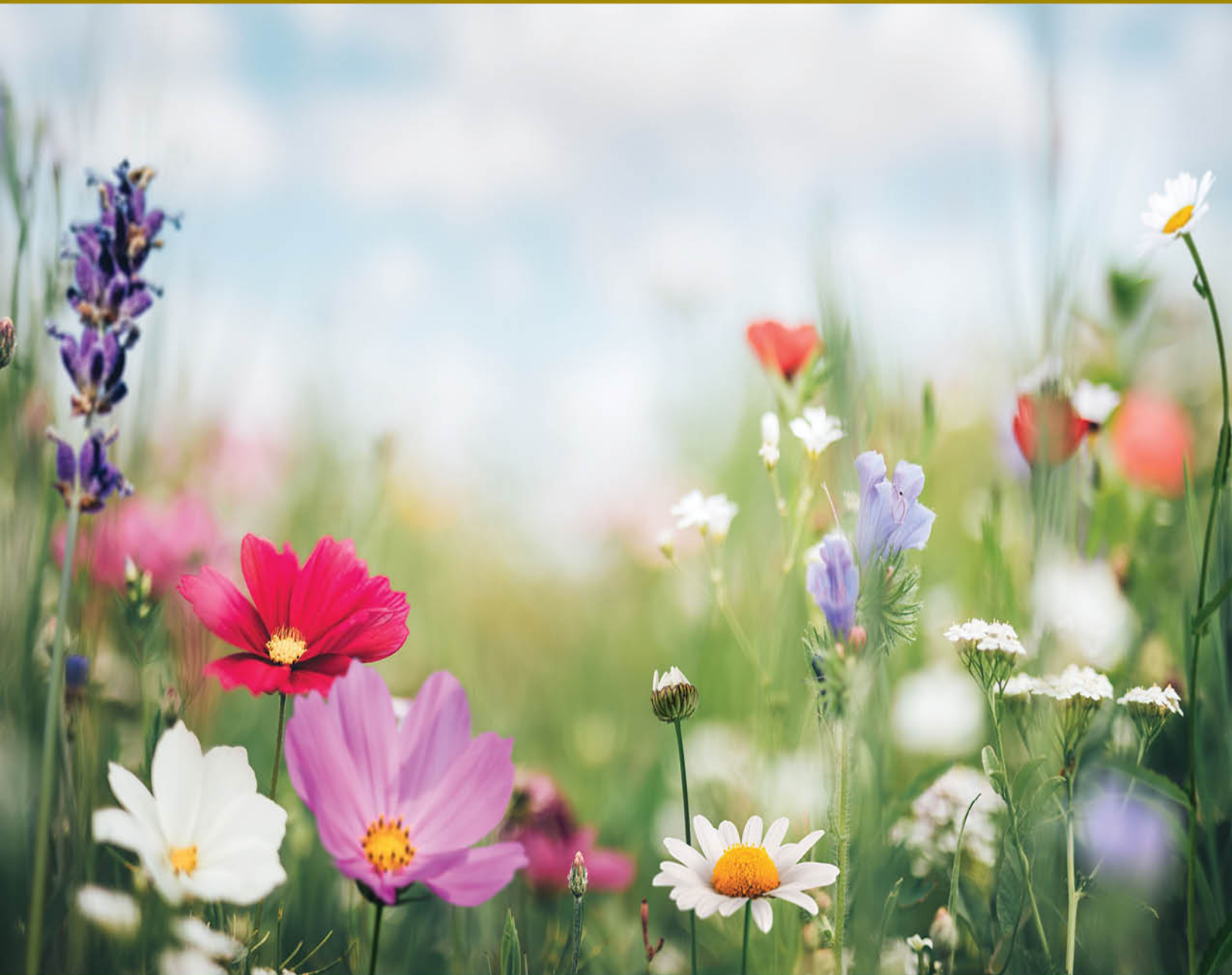

The freeze was certainly a teachable moment as to what plants are hardy enough to survive and which didn't really have a chance even if they were covered. Spring is here and everyone is enjoying the outdoors, including our beautiful lakes. While individual homeowners' opinions vary regarding the management of the lakes edges, we are rolling out a new program to better satisfy those wishes. Yellow markers are being provided to lakefront homeowners who choose to retain a buffer of bank vegetation in the edge of the water along their property. These markers are to be displayed on property on the designated days that the lakes will be sprayed by our lake management company. This will alert the workers to not spray the edge of these properties. We will monitor how this process goes and, as always, work to improve and streamline the process as needed.



Upgrades to the East Gate are occurring to improve responsiveness of the gate reader and allow taller vehicles to use the gate. Anytime work is being done, please be patient and cautious of workers. We would like to remind residents to keep up with their guest lists and make sure their contractors have valid drivers licenses in order to enter. If you haven't uploaded the Gate House app, you should do so. It makes entering guests to the gate list quick and easy right from your phone!

You may be seeing more alligators as the weather has warmed. While alligators have a natural fear of humans, here are some rules for coexisting with alligators adapted from Texas Parks and Wildlife Department*:

- Don't feed or entice alligators. Alligators overcome their natural shyness and become accustomed or attracted to humans when fed. It is now a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of up to \$500, to intentionally feed an alligator.
- Don't kill, harass, molest or attempt to move alligators. State law prohibits such actions.
- Don't allow small children to play by themselves in or around water.
- Don't - throw fish scraps into the water or leave them on shore.
- Although you are not intentionally feeding alligators, the end result can be the same.
- If you see an alligator while walking a pet make sure that your pet is on a leash and under your control. Your pet will naturally be curious, and the alligator may see an easy food source. It is wise to keep pets inside a fenced area or in the house.
- Call your TPWD regional office if you encounter a nuisance gator that has lost its fear of people.
- Enjoy viewing and photographing alligators from a safe distance of at least 30 feet or more. Remember that they're an important part of Texas's natural history, as well as an integral component of many wetland ecosystems.

Over the last four weeks we have been able to access the damage to the course from the freeze we had in February. There is significant damage to some of the greens, tees, fairways, and rough. We have determined the best way to get the grass to recover is to go to cart path only for the month of April. We will have our marshals on the course to make sure everyone is abiding by the rules. This will help ensure we get the course back to the condition it was in before the freeze. We need everyone's cooperation and understanding during this time. We will also be pushing the greens to get them back into good playing condition, so green speeds will be a little slower than we usually keep them. During April, we will be Aerifying greens, fairways, and slicing roughs to help promote growth as well as fertilizing. Thank you in advance for your patience during this time. We will also be roping off around tees and greens and some of the fairways with the most damage to ensure we keep carts off these areas. Hope to see you on the course, and please remember to sand your divots and repair your ball marks on the greens.

- Scoop the Poop to keep bacteria out of the lakes
- Keep grass clippings out of the lakes to minimize algae growth
- Leave grass 6" high for 10' from bank to filter runoff
- Retain 6' to 10' of bank vegetation in the water as a buffer to decrease erosion
- Use no or low phosphorus content (middle # less than 10) fertilizer on lawns and no fertilizer within 20' of waters edge to avoid algae growth

New Recreational Complex

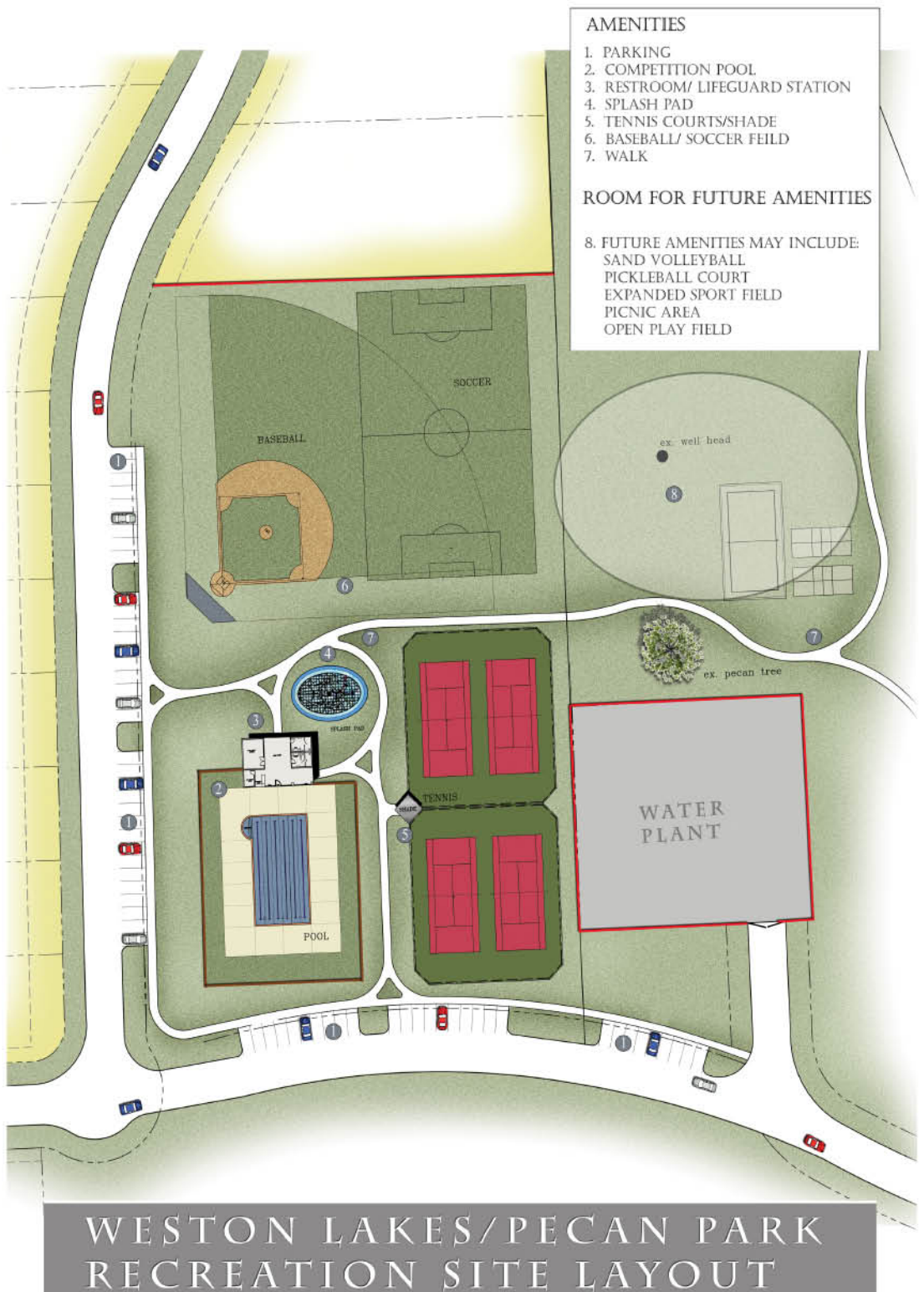
The Weston Lakes Country Club is pleased to announce the development of a new recreational complex exclusively for its members. Weston Lakes Country Club has acquired a 5-acre site in the middle of the Weston Lakes community, adjacent to Pecan Park, for this project.

The Weston Lakes Property Owners Association, the West Lakes Country Club, and the developer of The Park, retained a land planner to prepare a masterplan for the improvement and expansion of the existing Pecan Park, along with the addition of the recreational complex. The complex will include four tennis courts, a six-lane competition pool, a kid's splash pad, restrooms, buildings for concessions, and a multi-purpose sports field.

Existing Weston Lakes residents will access the complex from Westerdale Drive, within the community. New residents of The Park, the newest addition to Weston Lakes community, will access the complex from Bowser Road. Construction of the complex is slated to begin in the summer of 2021, with completion expected in the spring of 2022.

Once the new complex is open, the existing tennis courts at the original Weston Lakes Clubhouse, will be closed and used for future expansion needs. The adult pool will remain at the clubhouse, but it will be relocated to the existing competition pool and locker rooms.

Development of the new recreation complex will allow for improved facilities for all club members, safer and quicker access for facility users, and continued future expansion of club facilities at the existing club site.

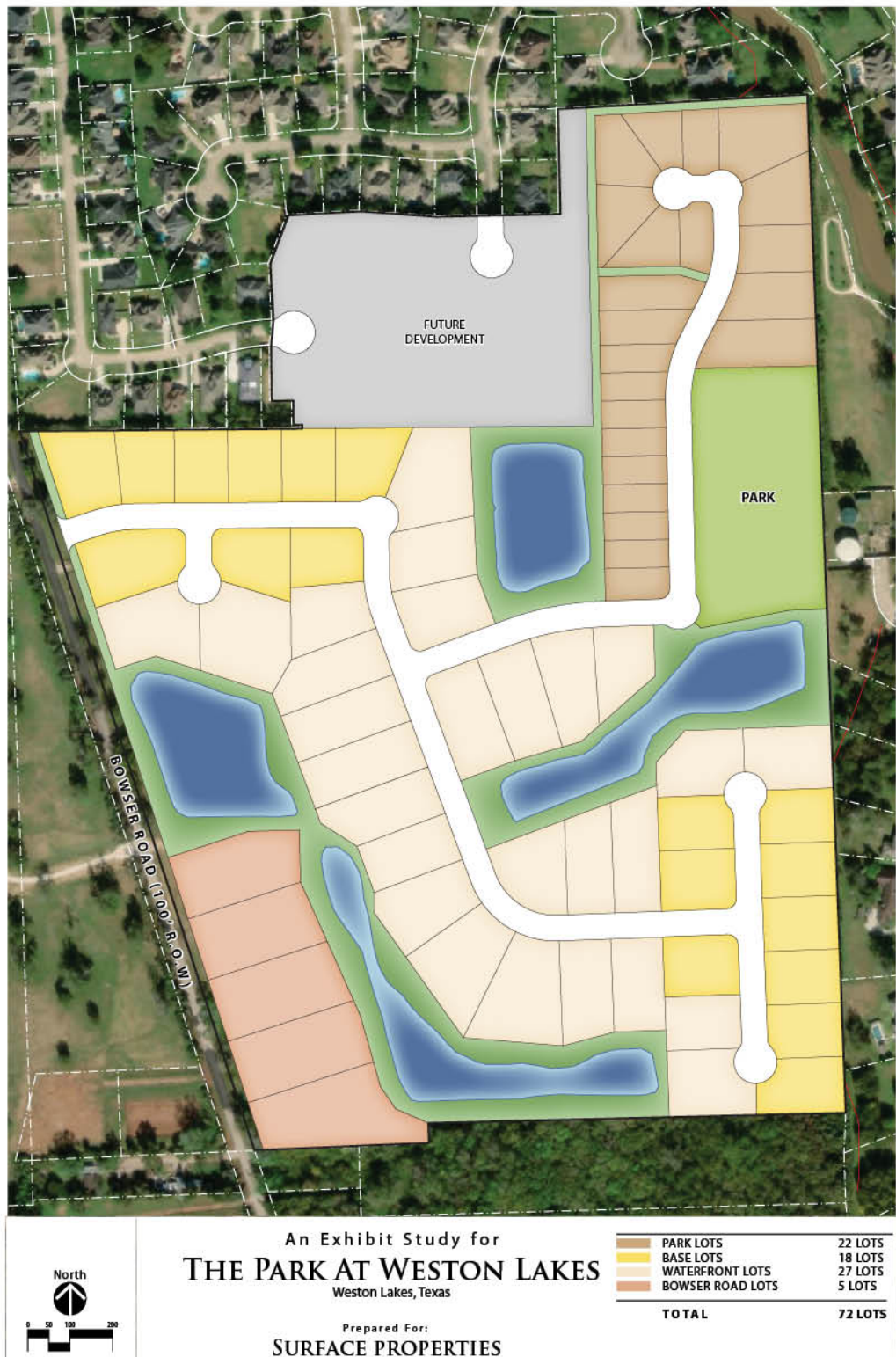

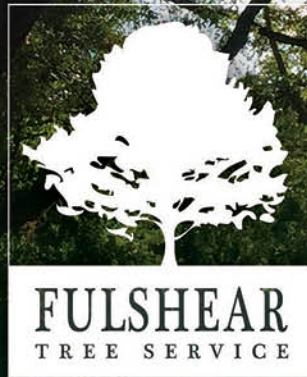

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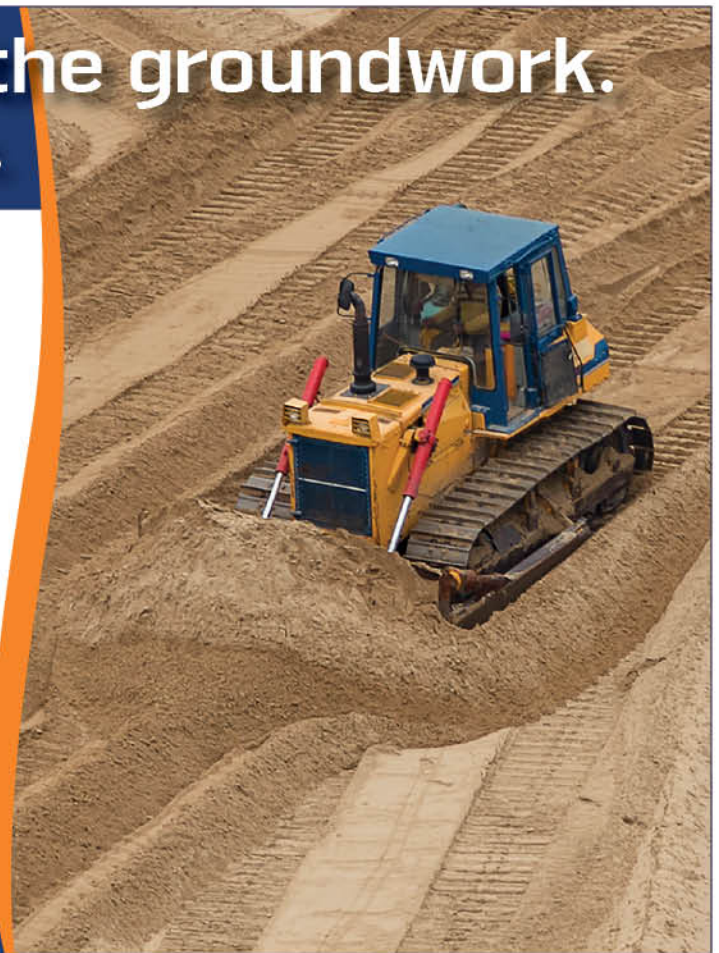
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
