




proud of. Below is an update on our ducklings on number 2. The kids are growing up.

### Shirley Cassell


Here are a few of her favorite things and some other fun nuggets of information...

# Helpful reminders for complying with the CCRs and facilitating gate entry process:

- Do not ask for package delivery to be left at the guard house. The gate attendants are busy keeping traffic moving and cannot have the liability of holding packages.
- Audio recording has been set up at the front entry gate so that any interactions of concern occurring between gate attendants and residents/visitors can be effectively investigated.
- Please remember that items such as wheelbarrows, bricks, empty pallets, etc., may not be stored on driveways and must be out of public view.
- Signs and flags (with exception of U.S., Texas, official military flags, and election signs/flags during a very specific time period) are NOT permitted in yards.


## Golf Course Maintenance




