We are planning to begin more strict enforcement of our golf course rules and regulations over the next few months and into the future, so please help us by adhering to the rules when you play.


Don't forget to set your clocks back one hour when you go to bed on Saturday, November 6th.



Pumpkin Protein Muffins

Ingredients:

- 15 oz Pumpkin, canned
- ½ cup Vanilla protein powder
- ½ cup Honey
- ¼ cup Avocado oil
- ½ tsp baking soda
- 1 ½ tbsp. Pumpkin pie spice
- ½ tsp Salt
- 1 tsp Vanilla extract
- 1 ½ cups Whole wheat flour
- ½ cup Greek yogurt
- ½ cup Milk



Start by pre-heating your oven to 350 degrees, then get your dry and wet ingredients mixed well in separate bowls. Form a well in the dry ingredient bowl and pour your wet ingredients into it. Fold the ingredients together until you get your pumpkin muffin batter! Scoop the batter evenly into muffin tins and bake for 25-30 minutes. Be sure to let them cool and enjoy!
