Especially during these times of stress and uncertainty, we need to find ways to relax and relieve ourselves of daily worries. This month I would like to ask for your assistance with some recurring issues that we have been noticing on the golf course.

The golf course may appear to be an inviting place for running, riding bicycles or walking your pet, however, the course is restricted to golfing use only. The course is open Tuesdays through Sundays with golfers on the course and we request for safety reasons of being hit by a ball that you avoid using the course for non-golfing use. When we do not have an event scheduled on Mondays, the golf course is closed for play and our maintenance crews are often spraying chemicals on the course that could potentially be dangerous. We are requesting all golfers and non-golfers to stay off the golf course on Mondays, and we appreciate your cooperation.

I would also like to clarify that the only private golf carts that are allowed on the golf course are carts that have been pre-approved by the Golf Shop. Private carts that are permitted on the golf course must have course-friendly tires among some other requirements. The golf member has to apply for registration and pay the annual trail fee and must display a current trail fee sticker on the cart. Other private carts are allowed in the neighborhood and in the club parking lot, but not on the golf course. We would appreciate your assistance in refraining from driving non-approved carts on the course.

Thank you to all of our members who continue to promote the club to their family, friends, neighbors and coworkers.




ANNUAL TRAIL FEE RENEWAL NOTICE

ow, summer started with a bang - hot and dry. Not to be deterred, our residents are still out enjoying the POA amenities in the parks, just not in the middle of the day! Looks like those pickle ball and basketball players in Riverwood Park are hitting



the courts a bit later. The Butterfly Gardens in Pecan Park are in bloom, attracting butterflies and people to enjoy them while they relax on the bench and read a book from the Little Free Library.

The feasibility of adding lights to the ball field in Pecan Park is being considered. We invite everyone to check out the new Brazos River Park, open during daytime hours. The gate to the park will be locked at approximately 7 in the evening.



In June, Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful presented a project

plan to the POA Board for building a Bird Sanctuary just beyond the Butterfly



Gardens in Pecan Park. The Board approved allowing KWLB to use the property for that purpose. KWLB will be seeking funding from sponsors, donors, and nature enthusiasts to develop this unused, narrow strip of land with all the things needed to attract birds and provide viewing opportunities in the park. Their plan includes planting native trees, shrubs, and plants; adding a bird friendly water feature; and providing food sources for birds.

Several sections of Pecan Lake have been dredged to remove built-up silt that was causing areas of very shallow water. The rest of Pecan Lake and the Oxbow Lake will be assessed to determine possible need for dredging and allow for it to be budgeted appropriately. Our lakes continue to be serviced by a lake management company to control invasive alligator weed and other undesirable plants. Remember, if you do not want your bank edge to be sprayed to allow plant life such as the beautiful native

Pickerelweed to grow there, you must place the POA-provided yellow markers on your bank before spray days. Upcoming spray dates are: 7/12, 7/26, 8/9, and 8/23. If you need new or replacement yellow markers, they are available in the POA office. One more reminder about the lakes (hard to believe we have to say this!) - swimming is not allowed. Remember we do have alligators who are usually good neighbors, but let's not tempt them!



Tree trimming is happening throughout the neighborhood to enhance the appearance, health, and safety of the trees. Landscaping improvement in Waterford and the Reserve is on the way, with limitations due to the heat. Some planting may be pushed until the weather is suitable for new plants.



In an effort to deter speeding on streets, an evaluation is underway to place additional speed humps in areas of greatest concern. A three-way stop will be re-implemented at the intersection of Waterbeck Street and Winster Drive. It's also the time of year when we assess the needs for repairs on streets, sidewalks, and curbs.

This annual evaluation and repair helps us to keep our streets in good shape and manage the cost over time.

The next Property Owners Association meeting will be in September on the third Thursday (no meetings in July and August). Enjoy your summer and stay cool!

eston Lakes is for the Birds Part 2! This community loves our birds, and KWLB is working on a long-term project to bring a bird sanctuary to Pecan Park. This will provide habitat to attract more birds and provide opportunities for the community to enjoy them. So what do birds need? They need food, water, and shelter. Last month we talked about food, so this month let's talk about water.



Most birds drink water every day. They also use water for bathing, to clean their feathers and remove parasites. After splashing around in a bath for a few minutes, a bird usually perches in a sunny spot and fluffs its feathers out to dry.

Supplying a fresh, clean supply of water will attract birds, even those that don't eat seed and won't come to a feeder. Birds seem to prefer baths that are at or near ground level, closely mimicking a natural, shallow puddle, with stones or branches that allow them to drink without getting wet. Water slowly dripping into the basin will catch the birds attention and attract even more birds.






