# Property Owners Association



he POA Board uses email to provide important timely information to property owners. This includes alerts such as street repair closures, changes in gate policies, events, and even emergency notifications at times. We can only provide this information when



your email is correct in our system. If you have changed emails, have not been receiving the POA emails, or would like to add an additional email address, please contact the POA office, and we'll take care of the rest!

That said, you have received an important email, or it will be coming to your inbox soon, from our management company, KRJ. We are implementing a new software system, called Vantaca, that will include a new POA email account, along with other new features.



A reminder that in order to adhere to our restricted access policies, it is necessary for property owners and residents to enter all vendors and service providers into your

Gatehouse visitor list to allow entry. The exceptions are the commercial delivery companies - UPS, Fedex, DHL, and Amazon. This also does not apply to U.S. Postal Service, electric, gas, and water utilities, Texas Pride Disposal, Best Trash, and emergency services vehicles that are always allowed access. Please remember to enter vendors - deliveries, landscapers, home health care, etc. into your visitor list. There is a new option for entering visitors to select "One Time Access" under Access Privilege in Gatehouse. This prevents someone, even if entered for only a one-day pass, from entering repeatedly throughout the day using your permission.

Is a bump in the road sometimes a good thing? We hope that sometimes it is! A new speed bump was added at the Reserve Gate as a bumpy reminder to proceed slowly and safely. We have several speed bumps throughout the neighborhood to encourage keeping the pace at a safer rate. If you have suggestions for an area that might benefit from another bump in the road, please contact the POA office.

Every property owner is welcome and encouraged to attend the POA meetings. Meetings are held at 7 p.m. on the third Thursday of every month, except July and August when there is no meeting, and December when the annual POA meeting occurs on the first Thursday of the month. All meetings are held in the Weston Lakes Country Club ballroom. Love to see you there!

One last thing... generators are, well, just not pretty. If you haven't screened your generator with landscaping or ACC approved fencing, it decreases neighborhood curb appeal, doesn't make for a thoughtful neighbor, and violates the CCRs. This education will target adults, bringing resources and ideas that can help all of us protect our children from this preventable death. Please join us for this important educational event. Weston Lakes is for the Birds! This community loves our birds and KWLB is working on a long term project to bring a bird sanctuary to Pecan Park. This will provide habitat to attract more birds and



provide opportunities for the community to enjoy them. So what do birds need? They need food, water, and shelter.

This month, we will talk about food. Native plants provide important food sources for birds. These plants are important hosts for certain insects such as butterflies and moth caterpillars, making

the insects rich in protein for birds to consume. Nesting birds will ultimately feed these sources of protein to their babies. Native plants that produce colorful berries and fruits will attract birds to

consume them. Birds also shape their migration patterns around native plants. Native plants that produce fleshy fruits are highly important to birds during the late summer and fall, providing birds with the energy requirements needed for a long migration.



Bird feeders provide a supplemental source of readily available food to attract the birds. Stay tuned for more about water and shelter next month.


