





Property Owners Association



lection time is coming up! There are three Property Owners Association Board positions and two Architectural Control Committee (ACC) positions up for election this year. Both the POA Board and ACC Committee are unpaid volunteers elected by fellow property owners. The POA board consists of five members and the ACC of three.

The Property Owners Association oversees and manages neighborhood common areas and amenities as well as ensuring that property owners obey the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CC&Rs), By-Laws and any other governing documents. The primary purpose of a POA is to provide a safeguard for owners' property values. POA dues are assessed to provide ongoing maintenance and improvement of neighborhood amenities. In Weston Lakes, membership in the Property Owners Association is a requirement of ownership. The Weston Lakes POA has responsibility and provides maintenance for more extensive common property than many other POAs, including almost 40 miles of streets, manned and automated entry gates, lakes, parks, and bridges.

The Architectural Control Committee oversees architectural requests and the associated compliance with applicable standards in the Conditions, Covenants, and Restrictions (CCRs). These standards serve to maintain the aesthetic and structural integrity to protect property values for all.

Riverwood Park Playground Equipment. There's always lots of activity at Riverwood Park, and the kids love playing there. Older playground equipment has been removed and bids solicited for upgraded replacements to provide even better playground activities.

Landscaping. It's been quite a year with a freeze, a heat wave, a drought, and heavy rains. This has challenged the landscaping upkeep in private yards and public places. Lake Village Park has received a facelift with trimming and building mulched beds around the shrubs. Lots of compliments received from neighbors in the area! Landscaping was enhanced around the POA office near the neighborhood front entry.

Visitor Access. The auto-attendant, which is the system that can be used to call in with your phone to add visitors to your guest list, is being upgraded to a newer cloud-based system with greater reliability. Any changes to the current process will be shared via e-mail from the POA Board as they are determined.

POA Meetings. All property owners are invited and encouraged to attend the POA meetings. Next meetings ~ October 20th, November 17th, and the Annual Meeting on December 1st. Look for the reminder sign at the front entry in advance of each meeting!

Below are a few notes on items of interest concerning the City of Weston Lakes.


