#### Hello Weston Lakes Neighbors,

It has been one year since we resumed submitting an article for the Weston Lakes monthly magazine. A number of things have changed over the past year, but most of those things for which we all moved to Weston Lakes have remained the same. We have made a commitment to a transparent government, but at the same time are also working behind the scenes to take care of business cost-effectively. A year ago, most of the calls we received dealt with the traffic light and concerns on FM 1093, and the frequent power outages in the neighborhood. The light is now working properly, traffic is moving as planned, and except for a few individual incidents, things are working as they should. The number of intermittent power outages have gone down significantly as the areas around the lines have been cleared. During the past year we have appointed an Emergency Management Coordinator and hired and Emergency Management Administrative Assistant. The positions for the Emergency Management section chiefs have been filled, and we are working on re-establishing our CERT program.



A quick reminder that all bunkers are out of play right now, and if you hit your ball into a bunker, we ask that you enter from the bottom of the bunker and exit from the bottom as well. The newly grassed area around the bunkers will not get established good until we have warmer weather and the grass starts to grow

again. We ask everyone to check-in with the Popshop before you play to find out what special things may be going on that day on the course. Thank you for your understanding.

\One other quick note on golf cart rules: The 90-degree golf cart rule should be used at all times, along with not driving the carts any closer than 30 yards to the green. Also, the golf course is for GOLFING ONLY (No bicycling, jogging, skateboarding, roller-blading, motorcycle's unauthorized carts, etc.)
