We are pushing the greens hard to transition into summer grass so green speeds will be a little slower than usual until we get full coverage on them. You might have noticed we have decided to renovate the fairway bunkers. We are reconstructing them to be more player and maintenance friendly. We are softening the faces and raising the bottoms to make easy access and flatter lies. All fairway bunkers are out of play until we complete the project, which should finish mid-June. Thank you for your patience during the construction we are hoping to have very little disruption in play. Hope to see you on the course and as always please repair your ball marks and sand your divots.

One other quick note on the golf course: Make sure to rake the bunker when you enter at any time. Always enter and exit on the low side of a bunker - do not jump or climb up steep faces, even if it might be faster. Climbing steep grass faces can cause serious turf damage in an area where it is already hard to grow grass. Walking up and down in sand faces can cause the sand to shift and collapse, which creates playability issues and a time - consuming repair job for the maintenance team.
