#### KEEP WESTON LAKES BEAUTIFUL

"To inspire community involvement in the preservation and enhancement of Weston Lakes natural beauty and environment"

As you relax by the pool with a cool drink on a hot July day, enjoy this quote from Lady Bird Johnson...

"Though the word beautification makes the concept sound merely cosmetic, it involves much more: clean water, clean air, clean roadsides, safe waste disposal and preservation of valued old landmarks as well as great parks and wilderness areas. To me... beautification means our total concern for the physical and human quality we pass on to our children and the future."

During her tenure as First Lady of the United States, Lady Bird Johnson served as a champion and advocate for conservation efforts and environmental legislation. She campaigned for improvement of the character of our highway systems. With the same enthusiasm and commitment, she initiated the "Beautification Project" as a solution to America's urban ills --pollution, trash, blighted waterways, and fractured communities.

Her inspiration and legacy carries on in the efforts of Keep Weston Lakes Beautiful, an affiliate of Keep Texas Beautiful and Keep America Beautiful. As KWLB takes a short summer break from our kids activities, here are a few conservation and beautification tips.

#### The 5 Rs for Reducing Waste

- Refuse -- Even if it's free (such as promotional freebies like single use cups or knick knacks) politely decline anything you don't need.
- Reduce -- bring your own grocery bags, your own water bottle to events, or reusable cup at the coffee shop. Avoid single use containers
- Reuse -- Repurpose jars as containers. Donate gently used items that you don't need, and give it to someone who can continue to use it.
- Recycle -- If you can't reuse it and it's recyclable, recycle it correctly.
- Rot -- Create a valuable (yet free) resource from food waste and organics by home composting. Recycle your fruits, vegetables, and yard trimmings into a nutrient-rich soil fertilizer while reducing waste in a landfill.

#### **Plant Native! Why Native Plants?**

- Drought-tolerant, naturally conserving our precious water resources.
- Provide habitat and food for birds, butterflies, bees, and other wildlife.
- · Don't need special pampering or fertilizing.
- Natural to their ecosystem (native birds, butterflies, and bees need native plants).
- · Help us to maintain biological biodiversity



#### Keen Our Lakes Beautiful

- · Scoop the poop to keep bacteria out of the lakes.
- · Keep grass clippings out of the lakes to minimize algae growth.
- Leave grass higher near the lake to filter runoff.
- Retain a six-bank vegetation buffer in the water, and manicure as needed to decrease erosion. You can prevent your bank edge from being sprayed with herbicide by posting the yellow marker sign available from the POA office.
- Avoid fertilizer on the lawn, but if using it, use low/no phosphorus fertilizer and do not fertilize within 20 feet of

the waters edge to avoid algae growth






