

Renovation Update:

I'm excited about the progress made over the last several years and the progress we will continue to make in the next five years. Several years ago, WLCC embarked on an approximately \$8,000,000 CIP program. Phase 1 & 2 have been completed with the development of a new Pro Shop, Fitness Center, 19th hole and Weston Room. We also upgraded the irrigation system for the golf course along with construction of the 716 Bunker Concession on the golf course. The opening of the new Weston Lakes CC Recreational complex, which includes 4 tennis courts, an 8-lane competition pool, a splash pad for the kids, a pavilion for restrooms and concession. The bunker renovations are complete and are in play now. While still a lot of work to go, we have begun the repair and replacement plan for the original golf paths, along with replacing and upgrading all course signage and markers.

Phase 3 is currently planned over the next year to 5 years. It will include:

- Expansion of club parking lot 1)
- 2) Upgrade of existing family pool and restrooms and convert to adult pool
- 3) Development of outdoor entertainment venue in adult pool area
- Continued renovation and replacement of golf course cart paths



Thanks to Shannon and his staff for the great job


