

Leaves are falling . . . and prices for everything are going up! Fall is budget time for the POA Board. The board worked long and diligently to review expenses for the year and comparison to budget. We also researched anticipated price increases for 2024 for the goods and services required to maintain our community and protect our property values. The 2024 budget was prepared and presented at the October POA meeting with NO INCREASE IN ASSSESMENTS.

Property Owners Association Expense Examples

- Entrance and exit gates -- Four gates for restricted access entrance and/or exit. Two are manned (personnel costs) and all have technology equipment to manage access that require upgrades and maintenance. Good news -- the new generator for the gate at The Reserve is in and fully functional.
- 86 concrete streets, four bridges, and entrances into neighborhood sections, street and traffic signs- maintenance and replacement costs.
- · Four neighborhood parks -- Riverwood, Pecan, Lake Village, and Brazos River -- upkeep, replacement of aged playground equipment, addition of amenities such as pickle ball courts. New playground equipment for Pecan Park is underway!
- Two neighborhood lakes -- Oxbow and Pecan -- herbicide application and dredging as needed
- Management Company contract
- Legal Expenses

The two previous numbers will remain active for a time period to ease the transition but will be disconnected in the near future. The Gatehouse App, which is a very convenient easy way to add visitors and vendors, continues to be available.

Below are a few notes on items of interest concerning the City of Weston Lakes.

Mayor Bob Wall, Alderman Bill Ragle and Alderwoman Linda Harnist were unopposed and therefore declared elected for another two-year term and therefore will not appear on the November ballot. However, there are fourteen (14) Constitutional Amendments on the November 7th ballot. Detailed information on each amendment is on the City of Weston Lakes website. www.cityofwestonlakes-tx.gov There are also several bonds for consideration on the November ballot as well. Two are Fort Bend County bonds: one dealing with mobility and the other dealing with parks and facilities. Lamar CISD also has a bond on the ballot to refurbish its deteriorating stadium. Information on each of those issues is also on the City of Weston Lakes website. I encourage all Weston Lakes registered voters to turn out and make your voices heard. I will be voting FOR the two Fort Bend Bonds and FOR the Lamar CISD bond. I believe anytime we can build or improve roads or facilities at today's costs that will benefit a vast number of people for years to come, it is a good thing. Weston Lakes traditionally has the highest voter turn-out in Fort Bend County. Please make sure that you are informed on each of those 14 amendments and the bond issues, and make your voices heard at the ballot box. 
