

Native plants are also low maintenance and can withstand our local weather. Some natives you might want to consider in your lower garden:

- · Scarlet sage (Salvia coccinea). Flowers much of the year and reseeds itself;
- · Indian blanket (Gaillardia pulchella). Great, bright bloomer. Reseeds itself:
- · Gulf muhly (Muhlenbergia capillaries). A perennial grass only 2-3 feet tall with stunning pink seed heads in autumn.


