

I hope everyone has been enjoying the summer so far. As the days are getting hotter now, please make sure to take care of yourself while out in the heat by drinking plenty of fluids. We have complimentary cups and lids in the pro shop for the water and ice machines.

Coming up this month is the LGA Ringer on May 31st and June 2nd. The MGA Lone Ranger is on June 8th, and the SMGA will have its Member-Partner on June 14th. June 15th is the Golf with Dad Tournament.




