As we start this summer months of golfing, here are some reminders about staying cool & hydrated.

- Always find the shade, if you can. Bring a sun umbrella with you on the green.
- Never pass up the water jugs on the course.
- Use a cold wet neck wrap for your neck. Academy sells reuseable ice cubes. Put them in the freezer, then you can put them in your wrap for added coolness.
- Use electrolytes in your water for hydration.
- If you have a fan, use it. (or get 2).

Here is a reminder on "PACE OF PLAY"

- · Help others play faster by" raking bunkers for them, handling the flagstick & searching for golf balls.
- Play ready golf. If it's safe & you're ready, hit your shot.
- · Watch your golf ball land to the end & go quickly to it so as not to lose sight of the ball.
- Plan your shot as you approach your ball, such as what club to use.
- Limit practice swings.
- · Read putts while walking to the green & while others are preparing to putt.
- · Record scores & put your clubs away on the next tee box. This one is very important.



Plastic Free July. Plastic-Free July is an annual month-long challenge to reduce one's use of single-use plastic and to discover alternatives. A study published in the journal, Nature Sustainability, analyzed 12 million



pieces of litter collected from oceans and rivers, shorelines, the sea floor, and open waters. Researchers found that 80% of items were plastic, and nearly half (44%) was related to takeout food and drinks-specifically, single-use bags, plastic bottles, food containers, and food wrappers. Other items included plastic caps and lids and disposable cutlery.

Packagings like plastic containers, cutlery, drinking cups, and straws make up about 269,000 tons of plastic found in the oceans. What can you do? Remember the 3Rs - Reduce, Reuse, Recycle. Avoid single use plastics like beverage bottles and grocery bags. Carry your own reusable mug, tumbler, cutlery, and take out containers. Look for options with less plastic packaging.

Challenge yourself to use less plastic for a month, and who knows, it just might become a habit!
