#### GARDEN SOCIAL CLUB

This is a challenging time of year for us with the heat and humidity! One way that the Garden Social Club is trying to "Beat the Heat" is by continuing our recent summer tradition of Chill at the Grill at the Waterside Grill on the last Tuesday of the month at 11 a.m. Come join us to enjoy each others company, have a cold drink, or order lunch! As we all endure the hot days of summer, here are some ways to give your summer garden a boost.

- Hydrate. When it's hot, dry and muggy, the best thing is a nice cold drink. Your plants need some H2O, too. The trick to keeping your garden hydrated is not to water more, but to water smarter. Water plants deeply in the morning so they have the entire day to soak it up. Make sure you water a minimum of 6 inches down. Don't guess – check your soil moisture level by using a trowel to dig 6 inches down.
- Keep your soil covered with 2- 4 inches of organic mulch. Using straw, grass cuttings, shredded leaves, etc. for mulch will keep the soil cooler and prevent it from drying out as quickly. Don't use too thick of a layer though. While mulch can help preserve moisture in the soil, a thick layer can also prevent rainfall from reaching the soil underneath.
- · Space your plants farther apart. Plants spaced closely together will compete strongly with each other for water. If you are able to space your plants farther apart, they will experience less stress during periods of extreme heat.

• Keep your garden well weeded. Weeds usually have much more vigorous root systems, and they can out-compete with your plants for water in the soil.

August's Chill at the Grill will be August 27th at 11 a.m. at the Waterside Grill. We are collecting dues for the upcoming year of Friendship, Flowers and Fun. If you pay your dues now, they are just \$25 for the year. After the September meeting dues go up to \$30.

As we move into August, the summer is passing by, but the heat is not giving us much of a break. So, make sure to grab a bag of ice and a cup water from the pro shop before teeing off.

We would also like to ask for your help on keeping up with the pace of play since we have an increase of play on our course. The typical pace of play for 18 holes of golf is 3 hours and 45 minutes to 4 hours, and we would appreciate all

golfers pacing their group to stay within that time frame. We are striving to make everyone's golfing experience enjoyable, and we appreciate your assistance in doing that.

General play rules to remember, 90 degrees from cart path should be used at all times, except when restricted to cart-path-only days. This does not mean to drive down the rough to get to your ball. Also, do not drive any closer than 30 yards from the green. Carts must remain on cart path on all Par 3 holes.

Do not drive golf carts onto home owners' property, and please abandon golf balls that go into the private yards on the golf course. Thanks to everyone for your corporation.

Our goal is always to provide a quality experience for all of our members and their guests.

#### **3Rs Tip Box**



#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

With so many new residents and golf members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain our food and beverage service charge policy.

Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait staff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public, the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that particular table as a tip.

However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage.

In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times.

All our servers are paid an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this change in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience.
