

We'd like to take this opportunity to thank Linda Harnist for her outstanding service and recognize her during our 5th Annual Weston Lakes Proud month.


Linda Harnist moved to Weston Lakes in 1999. Previously a resident of Sugar Land, Linda came to Weston Lakes in search of its peace and quiet, its spacious comfort, and its values of community, beauty and security. What a joy moving to Weston Lakes was and has continued to be ever since.

Linda enjoyed a lengthy career in real estate, including work for a major national builder, and local customer builders. She received National, Regional, and Local Salesperson of The Year Awards during this time. From 2004 to 2006, Linda was a sales professional for a smaller, semi-custom builder selling in many Houston-area communities, from the Woodlands to inside the Loop.

In May of 2006, Linda retired to pursue travel abroad. She spent time in both Perth, Australia and Paris, France, where she spent her time in some of the city's most scenic and historic quarters. By that time of the next year, Linda was excited to return home, where a very active role in the community awaited her.

Weston Lakes officially incorporated in 2008, and Linda regularly attended monthly City Council meetings and participated with city officials, and volunteers in the City's Beautification Project, clearing FM 1093 of litter from Fulbrook to Simonton.

Elected to the City Council in 2016, Linda assumed the responsibilities of the city's Finance Officer, and Mayor Pro Tem. Linda has completed numerous hours of mandated state coursework on finance. "Texas Public Funds Investment Act"; "Open Meetings Act"; "Public Information Act"; "Retail Follows



Rooftops Act"; "Six Secrets to Construction Success Course", and "What Oil and Gas Means for Cities", etc. Linda holds certificates in the mandated courses and extra-curricular courses with the State of Texas. She has also attended TML and HGAC seminars, and Mayor/Council monthly meetings. Continuing education is always on-going!

She has served continuously on the Weston Lakes Emergency Management Committee as both "Committee Secretary", and "Chief of Finance and Administration" since the EMC inception in 2009. Linda completed NIMS course work which includes becoming Certified as an Emergency Response Team Member (CERT), and holds further Certificates in: ICS 100, ICS 200, ICS 300 and 400, ICS 700, ICS 800 and the Finance Course, "Show Me the Money". As a member of The Weston Lakes Emergency Management Team, she has participated in numerous drills, Tabletop Exercises, distribution of Emergency Packets to Weston Lakes homes, and recorded minutes of the monthly meetings since 2009.


