Driving Range Policy Update: Irons Only When Teeing Area Is Mid-Way Forward



Due to advancements in golf technology, the distance that clubs can hit the golf ball has increased significantly. As a result, our driving range, particularly from the mid-way forward teeing area, has become too short to accommodate drivers, fairway woods, and certain hybrid clubs.

Effective Immediately:

- 1. Irons Only Policy:
 - When the teeing area is set to mid-way forward, only iron clubs may be used. This restriction aims to enhance safety and ensure an enjoyable practice environment for all members.
- 2. Signage:
 - Signs will be displayed to clearly indicate when the "Irons Only" policy is in effect.
- 3. Compliance:
 - Members are expected to adhere to this policy. If a member is found to be using noncompliant clubs, they will be held responsible for any damage to property.
 - Continued disregard for these restrictions may result in suspension or termination of golfing privileges.
