

Hope that everyone enjoyed their Thanksgiving and had safe travels. November started out with a lot of rain during the 1st week, thus cart path only and some canceled playday games. The Annual Weston Cup took place, and the last Interclub League for 2024 was played.

The Annual Weston Cup was played on 11/9 & 10. The weather was perfect both days, and the course conditions were great. This tournament is The MGA vs. SMGA and consists of 3 different games over the 2 days. The 1st day is 9 holes of Best Ball and 9 holes of Alternate shot. On the 2nd day, there are 18 holes of Singles Match play. The SMGA has not been able to defend its title for the last 6 years. This year we tried a new strategy. Approximately 28 players signed up and the decision was made to use the 18 lowest H/P players. There are 18 points to be made each day. After day 1, the score was MGA 10.5 to SMGA 7.5. The match was MGA 12 to SMGA 6. We lost by 9, but these results were better than the previous years. There were 14 matches that came down to the 18th hole: Best Ball (6), Alternate Shot (3), and Singles (5). Next year we're working at using a different strategy, using a mixture of H/C's.

On 11/14 the Inter-Club League was hosted at the Quail Valley C.C. W/L's was represented by: M. Johnson, J. Brooks, R. Kimbrell, K., J. Kemper, J. Weant, M. Duncan, H. Wilson, and T. Marlatt. With some of our top players, we finally got 1st place. Thank you, gentlemen, for representing W. L.

A big thank you to Harry Wilson for being W/L's Representative and Organizer of the Inter-Club League for so many years. Harry is retiring from this position. 


