

## GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

Spring is finally here and the course is starting to green back up we have finished our pre-emergent herbicide applications. Starting March 1st we will be designating one hole on the front nine and one hole on the back nine as cart path only for four weeks at a time. We will have signs at the tee so you will know it is cart path only as well as signs in the pro shop. The reason for this is we have had more play than in the past due to the mild winter and the fairways have become compacted. We will be relieving the compaction by aerifying the fairways which will start this March. Thank you for your help with this and as always please repair your ball marks and sand your divots.



**Habitat Heroes!!** Join KWLB for "Mighty Migration" on March 22nd from 9-10:30AM in the Bird Sanctuary where the kids will learn to use binoculars to focus on our feathered friends. Spring bird migration will be starting! Can you believe that little warblers and other birds fly thousands of miles during this annual event? There will be games, activities, and crafts to have fun and teach the kids about the mighty migration. And, of course, there will still be donuts!! Bring out the kids for a great time.



Native plants are for the birds and for your pleasure too! Plants native to our ecoregion have evolved alongside our birds, insects, and mammals so they provide the specific food sources and habitat to help them thrive. Native plants can add beauty to our landscape with the added benefit of being relatively low maintenance. They often require less water and no fertilizer. Many have deep roots that prevent erosion and absorb water to prevent runoff and flooding. The native perennials are freeze tolerant and come back each year. Annuals reseed themselves. So once your native garden is established there is no more buying plants year after year!

People often ask where they can find Texas native plants. Enchanted Gardens on FM 359 and FM 723 carries a nice selection. HEB has partnered with the Native Plant Society of Texas (a great resource!) to sell Texas native plants in many of their stores. In the Fall you can plant seeds for an inexpensive flower garden the next spring. A great source for these seeds is Native American Seed Company where you can purchase them online. Neighbors with native plants that reseed are often willing to share for free. **Go Native!**




