Coming up this month is the MGA Member/Member, starting with a Calcutta Friday night May 2nd, and play on May 3rd & 4th. The SMGA will hold its Ringer on May 8th & 9th. The LGA will hold their Member/Member on May 21st.

I would like to give a big "Shout Out" to all of our Operation 36 Junior golf Academy students for the Great Job they did this last semester on taking their golfing skill to the next level. One other quick note on the golf course: Make sure to rake the bunker when you enter at any time. Always enter and exit on the low side of a bunker – do not jump or climb up steep faces, even if it might be faster. Climbing steep grass faces can cause serious turf damage in an area where it is already hard to grow grass. Walking up and down in sand faces can cause the sand to shift and collapse, which creates playability issues and a time-consuming repair job for the maintenance team.

Our goal is always to provide a quality experience for all of our members and their guests.

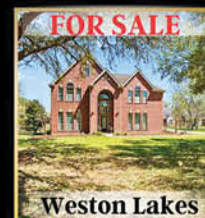


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FROM THE MAYOR

Hello Neighbors,

Thank you to the 100+ citizens who showed up for the Town Hall Meeting on April 3rd. It was good to be able to present the facts about Proposition A on the May 3rd ballot and dispel many of the rumors and misinformation spread via social media. We had about 10 citizens who asked great questions in order to gain more clarification on the issue.

Based on some of the questions asked and some of the comments via social media, I think we need to revisit some of the items I have put forth in previous newsletter articles concerning the different entities in Weston Lakes and their areas of responsibility.

- The City of Weston Lakes was formed to prevent annexation from a larger city. The city is your voice outside of the gate, communicating with the County and other entities to deal with issues such as debris removal after Hurricane Beryl. The city has NO PROPERTY TAX and manages funds in a manner that should never necessitate a property tax. The mayor and five city council members are elected to staggered two-year terms.

- The Property Owners Association maintains the streets, streetlights and parks. Revenue comes from an annual assessment. POA board members

are elected to staggered two-year terms. The POA contracts with the Precinct 1 Constable to provide a deputy exclusively for Weston Lakes.

- Municipal Utility District #81 provides water, sewer and trash pickup for about 90% of the residents. MUD #81 collects a property tax but has relatively low monthly water bills. Those who do not live within MUD #81 have service provided by a private company called Aqua Texas. Primarily, in the Riverwood section, they do not pay the tax but have generally higher monthly water bills. The MUD board is elected from local residents to staggered four-year terms. Aqua Texas is a for-profit corporation.

- ESD#4 provides fire and EMS service for Weston Lakes. They are funded by a property tax. The five-member ESD board is appointed by the County Commissioner.

- The Fort Bend Sheriff's department is the primary law enforcement entity for Weston Lakes and is supported by the Precinct 1 Constable. County property taxes pay for those services.

Our next City Council meeting will be on Tuesday, May 20th, at 6 p.m. in the Weston Lakes ballroom. The public is always encouraged to attend.

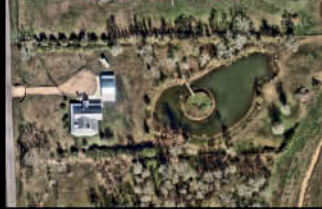

DID YOU KNOW?

With so many new residents and golf members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain our food and beverage service charge policy.

Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait staff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public, the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that particular table as a tip.

However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage.

In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times.

All our servers are paid an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this change in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience.
