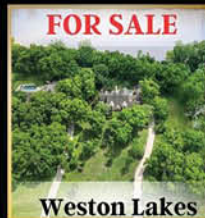
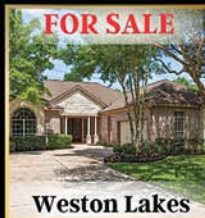
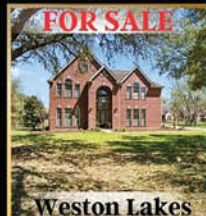

Summer Water Safety Classes: The City of Weston Lakes is in the process of organizing swim safety classes for the kids and grandkids of Weston Lakes residents. Look for information on how to sign up on the City of Weston Lakes website. westonlaketexas.gov

Sales Tax: The voter approved sales tax goes into effect October 1, 2025. Until that time make sure you designate your address for all online purchases as Weston Lakes so you will pay 6.25% rather than 8.25%. Many e-commerce sites default to Fulshear when you enter your zip code as 77441 since our mail is delivered from the same post office located in Fulshear. After October 1, making sure you use Weston Lakes as your city address and using the extended 9-digit zip code will help ensure the 2% local tax goes to the City of Weston Lakes rather than to the City of Fulshear.

Council Meetings: Regularly scheduled City Council meetings will be in the Weston Lakes ballroom on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 6 p.m. unless noted on the city website due to a holiday conflict or meeting cancellation. The public is always welcome.

Weston Lakes Reminder: Every time we pass through our security gates we are reminded of the wonderful and unique place in which we live. The City of Weston Lakes was incorporated in part to make sure you are virtually free from municipal rules and regulations. Please keep in mind that with that freedom comes some individual responsibility. Great American Cleanup. This spring while diving into the trash that others had left behind, KWLB youth volunteers learned the importance of putting litter in its place and encouraging others to do the same. Habitat Heroes. In May the KWLB Habitat Heroes converged on the Butterfly Garden in Ragle Park for a Pollinator Patrol event. The kids used loupes to closely examine specimens and the n took a loupe home to continue their investigations. As they patrolled the gardens they discovered the critical relationship between native plants and the insects needed for pollination and were invited to take native aquatic milkweed home to plant in their own gardens. Using an application called Seek by iNaturalist on a mobile phone, they used image recognition technology to identify the plants and animals.

Thank you to Jennifer Francois for sponsoring our KWLB events, Wild Birds Unlimited who sponsors our bird feed at the Bird Sanctuary for bringing out native pollinator plants for sale, and to Russell Braun, Edward Jones financial advisor, for supplying the loupes for the kids.



Go Native - Plant of the Month. This month we are highlighting the Partridge pea (*Chamaecrista fasciculata*). These three feet tall annuals provide eye-catching yellow blooms June through October. They do well in sun or part shade and dry to moist soils. Butterflies and bees love them and they attract seed-eating birds. This lovely plant is a larval host for Orange Sulphur and Sleepy Orange butterflies.

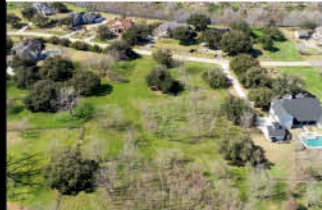
