

This holiday season, members of the Women's Association gathered for a festive and inspiring Christmas tree decorating tutorial led by Raven Debose who shared her signature approach to designing trees that truly dazzle. The focus of the workshop was on creating visual interest using ribbon; a technique that instantly adds dimension, texture, and a touch of elegance to any tree.

Raven began by encouraging attendees to view their Christmas tree as a "canvas," reminding everyone that design balance is key. She demonstrated how to work with wired ribbon in complementary patterns

and tones-mixing solids, metallics, and prints to create depth. Instead of traditional bows, Raven showcased how ribbon sprays can be layered in a cascading or crisscross pattern to draw the eye throughout the tree, ensuring every angle sparkles with intention.

One of the highlights of the tutorial was Raven's "rule of three" tip: combining three different ribbon styles—one wide, one narrow, and one with shimmer—for a designer-quality finish. She also demonstrated how to tuck ribbon ends into the branches to create a natural, woven look rather than wrapping it around the tree. Members appreciated learning how these small adjustments can transform an ordinary tree into a professional, showroom-worthy display.

DID YOU KNOW?

Waterside Grill With so many new members joining the country club recently, we wanted to take this opportunity to

explain our food and beverage service charge policy. Most servers in the food and beverage industry are paid a small hourly wage, and the majority of their income is derived from tips. The federal minimum wage for wait staff is actually much lower than the standard minimum wage for other workers. However, unlike a normal restaurant that is open to the public, the Waterside Grill has restricted access and therefore the number of people dining in the Grill can be very unpredictable. The club has always added a service charge to all checks, which is standard

in the country club industry, and in the past it went directly to the servers that were working that

particular table as a tip.

However, we found it was very difficult to hire and retain staff willing to work during the off-peak hours (breakfast, lunch and some dinner shifts) because many times there are simply not enough customers to generate enough in tips to earn a livable wage. In order to hire and retain a qualified staff to serve our members at all times, we found it was necessary to pool the service charge and spread out among the servers in the form of a higher hourly wage. This helps to ensure them of a fair income whether they were working during peak or non-peak times.

All our servers are paid an hourly wage that is much higher than the industry standard, and although the standard 18% service charge on your check does not go directly to your server for your meal, it does subsidize a higher wage rate for your server. Of course any additional tip that you choose to add to your check, does go directly to your server for that meal. While this change in compensation structure may have a higher operating cost, it has accomplished our primary objective of retaining a qualified and stable workforce to service your dining experience. We look forward to serving you soon
