#### SENIOR MEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION

As we head into the holiday season, I would like to wish everyone a belated Happy Thanksgiving, along with a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. The SMGA has had an eventful year, and we look forward to more fun in 2026. And to celebrate the 2025 season, we will be holding our annual SMGA Christmas dinner on Tuesday, December 9th, starting at 6:00 PM.

This year, one event that the SMGA has been active in are the WSIGA InterClub matches. There were 8 rounds played throughout the year, culminating with the final matches which were held on November 11th at Falcon Point. Our team finished in 3rd place this time, which means we finish the 2025 season in 3rd overall (behind Pecan Grove and Falcon Point). Congratulations to all who participated and thanks to Dave Clarke who served as the InterClub organizer this year.

In early November, a group of 27 SMGA members went to Coushatta Casino Resort for two days of golf and après golf. A good time was had by all, but there has been some debate concerning the quality of golf played. This was the second such trip this year and the group has logged 96 rounds of golf, with only four of them resulting in a net under-par score. The debate revolved around whether the group needed to spend less energy drinking and gambling and put more effort on the golf. On the membership front, we have two new board members lined up for 2026. Bill Stevens will assume the Secretary role, while Brian Lloyd will serve as Treasurer. Finally, we recently added another new member -please welcome Curtis Hartin to the SMGA. Year to date we have had 17 new members join our ranks and our headcount now stands at 169.

#### Golf Course Maintenance & Tips Cart etiquette reminder

Year round we are under the 90-degree rule. Please help preserve the course by staying on the path as long as possible and avoid all roped off or wet areas.

#### **Practice Facility Maintenance**

When hitting balls on the range, the best way to help maintain the turf is to hit divots in a linear pattern instead of staggered or concentrated. This will help the grass grow back fuller and more quickly. I would like to encourage everyone to practice good etiquette and divot pattern while practicing at Weston Lakes Country Club. #### **Booking Tee Times**

You can use the online system to book for a three-some or four-some, but we ask if you have a single or double tee time that you call into the pro shop to make that reservation. There are times that you cannot see online that the pro shop can see for over the phone booking so you will end up getting a better tee time! This allows us as a staff to manage the tee sheet better and help us plan for the day.

#### FROM THE MAYOR

Hello Neighbors,


A View from 30,000 Feet After living in Weston Lakes for the last 18 years and serving as mayor for the last four, the following are a few items that I want to share:

City government, like other forms of government, does NOT operate like a business. Despite our desire to work efficiently, government works deliberately by design, thus slowing progress but preventing radical change. Government personnel turnover is constant. In the four years I have served as mayor, we have changed four of our five city council members, and we have had three different city secretaries. In just four years, I have now served longer than 12 of the other 17 mayors in Fort Bend County.

Growth is inevitable. Our July 2025 population estimate was 4024. The surrounding area is booming, and schools and roads are being built rapidly. The current Westpark Toll Road project is scheduled for completion in June 2026. The next extension, which will pass in front of Weston Lakes, should not begin for at least five years. Bowser Road improvements will begin as soon as the last few bits of land are acquired, and the finished road will be similar to what FM 1093 currently looks like. Ashe Road will merge with Bowser south of FM 1093, and Pool Hill will be straightened so there will be just one four corner intersection. Pool Hill will be a four-lane parkway going north.

Halloween is a remarkable event in Weston Lakes. Thank you to those who make it a memorable one for the kids in our community. Thank you, too, to the kids in Weston Lakes. The trick-or-treaters who stopped by our house were extremely polite and appreciative. It was so encouraging to watch so many really good kids having some traditional fun.




